

SAWONCHAK, Michael (alias of FEDAK) States 6 Polish partisans (three men and three women) crossed the Czech border near Hals on night 6-7 Nov. 49, after firing on two SNB border guards. The group was apprehended by the German Border Police and sent to Tirschenreuth to await disposition for illegal border crossing and illegal possession of weapons. (F-2)

SAVONCHAK, the admitted leader, says he had received in orders from the headquarters of UPA in Regensburg to bring the group to Regensburg.

SATONCHAK says he is an active member of the Bandera Partisan organization, and that he had received orders to leave Poland about two months ago.

Members of the group were as follows:

SAVONCHAK, Michael, male, born 9 May 1924 at Lemberg, Poland BASSAJ, Michael, male born 12 Nov. 1923 at Potibitsch, Ukraine.

GAJCCHA, Vladzimier, male, born 12 Feb. 1925 at Vyzlou, Pland.

SACZKAWSKA, Wala, female, born 5 Dec. 1926 at Krynatca, Poland.

GERA, Maria, female, born 28 May 1930 at Vyzlou, Poland.

CHODAK, Stefanie, female, born 14 Oct. 1926 at Hoczeg, Poland.

The members of the group were transported to Amberg for trial, which was to have taken place on 15 Nov. 1949

1. Reference is made to your by memorandum IRP/579, dated il October 1955, subject as scove, whose name you desired checked against the files of this office.

- 2. The files of this office reflect the following information concerning the subject of your request. In a report dated 18 November 1349 from the Department of the Army, from en untested source, content evaluation probably true', it was stated that on the night of G or 7 November 1947, six Ukrainian partisans, three men, one of whom was Michael SAVONCAK, and three women, crossed the Caech border near Huls. During this crossing, the party was approached by two members of the SMB (Csech State Security Police) who immediately opened fire with their weapons. The partisans who were armed, returned the fire, killing one of the SMB personnel and wounding the other men. On the morning of 7 November 1949, the partisen band was apprehended by the German Border Police, and sent to Tirschenreuth, Germany, to await disposition for illegal border crossing and illegal possession of weapons. (Reference: Counter Intelligence Corps, Report VII-2100.0, subject: BAVCHCAK, Michael)
- In a report dated 10 July 1951, it was indicated that Mikhailo FEDAK. a resident of a Regensburg, Germany, DP camp during the winter and spring of 1949, was known to have traveled in Poland from July to September 1949, on a clandestine courier mission for the OUN/Bardera (Organisation of Ukrainian Nationalists). According to a confessed Polish agent, his moves while in Poland were reported systematically to the Polish Intelligence Lervice by a number of Ukrainian girls working for the Polish service, and it was suspected that he himself had been recruited by that service. In the autumn of 1949, he brought two confessed recruits of the Polish Intelligence Service out of Poland, one of whom subsequently became his wife. He was convicted of

illegal border crossing and possession of firearms in Germany in December 1949. Under interrogation in Germany he withheld information from representatives of this Agency allegadly because of his oath to secrecy administered by the OUM/Banders. Subject was described as extremly short, with blond curly hair and a poor complexion. (The information in this paragraph was furnished to the Displaced Persons Commission on 10 July 1951.)

- 1. The files of USU-CIA reflect the following information concerning the subject of your inquiry.
- 2. Hikhailo Halk, a resident of a Regensberg DP camp during the winter and sprin; of 1949, is known to have traveled in Poland from July to September1949, on a clandestine courier mission for the UUN/Banders (Organisation of Exrainian Nationalists).
