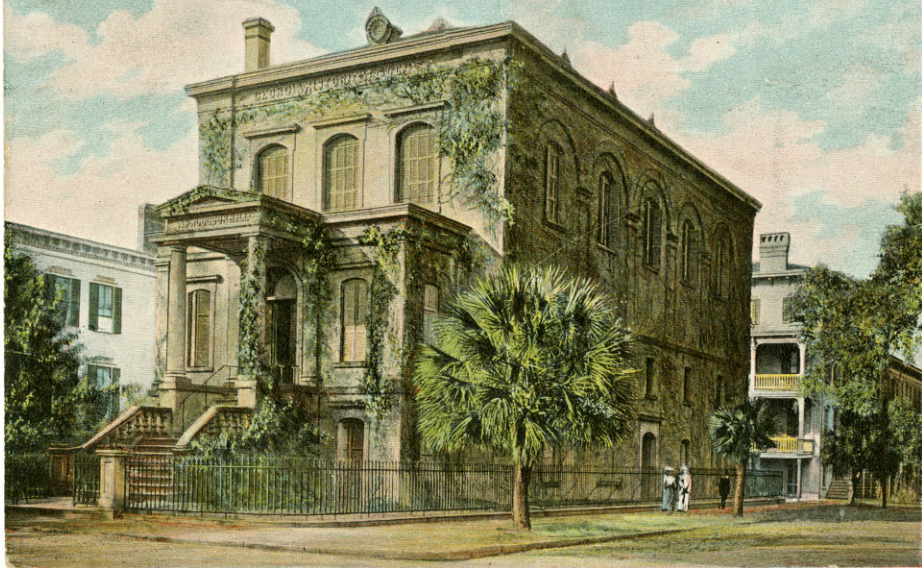


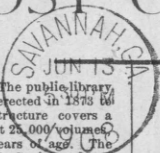

SAVANNAH PUBLIC LIBRARY. The public library of Savannah is in Hodgson Hall, a building erected in 1873 in the memory of Wm. Brown Hodgson; the structure covers a space 94 by 41 feet. The library contains about 25,000 volumes, and is open to all white residents over 14 years of age. The city contributes \$3,000 and the Historical Society, \$600, annually to its support.
