# WIKIDATA COMMUNITY

Has a growing reputation for reproducing Wikidata items about local contexts. Recently planned the mapping of historical mosques and cemeteries.

This in turn can be helpful for the ESEAP Hub in undertaking **collaboration between countries** in developing Wikidata content and **sharing experiences** with other communities.



# WIKISOURCE COMMUNITY

First established in 2020 after a Wikisource competition, the community centers on the transcription of Indonesian and local language books and texts.

Providing opportunities to get involved in the Hub, they can engage in **content development** and **piloting of Wikisource features**. They could also help with the ongoing Wiki Rescues Manuscripts project.



# DENPASAR COMMUNITY

Formed in 2019, this community has achieved history by starting the Balinese Wikipedia and the Balinese Wikisource. They have worked hard to preserve local culture in Wikimedia projects.

Given their success in **preserving their culture** through Wikimedia projects, they were able to introduce their **local heritage** to the international community, such as the efforts to save lontar and record *melukat* ritual in Bali to bridge the content gap.



And **11 other communities in Indonesia** can contribute to the **growth of Wikimedia projects** in the ESEAP region.
