C. 1. Forwarded herewith, as requested in Department of the Army radio WX 993E7, 9 February 1950, are the following: a. Listing of parsonnel currently receiving gross salaries of \$7500 or more per annua. b. Breakdown of positions by general fields of activity, corresponding generally to the tabulation shown on page 946 of the hearings before the Sub-committee of the Committee on Appropriations, House of Ropresentatives, Foreign Aid Bill, 1950. c. Breakdown of positions by grade classification and organizational segment, corresponding generally to the tabulation shown on page 954 of the same hearings. 2. For Japan, two sets of tabulations under items 1b and 1c above have been prepared: a. The first corresponds to the 2018 positions contained in the original green sheet estimates, as adjusted. b. The second reflects most recent estimates of requirements, which have been reduced since the original estimates to a total of 1794 positions. These reductions have been made possible through the recreanization of Civil Affairs Activities in Japan, and the reduced workload in the staff sections of General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, resulting from maximum transition of responsibilities to the Japanese under the program of relamition of controls. 3. The resently effected reorganization of Military Government in the Ryukyus has changed both position and fund requirements so materially that no attempt has been made to furnish data corresponding to the 392 positions originally contained in the green sheets for Project 416. Data submitted herewith reflects most recent estimate of requirements (377 US and Filipino positions) .

4. In view of the above significant changes in requirements, revised green sheets for both Japan and the Ryukyus have been prepared and will be handcarried to Washington with the original copies of inclosures, by budget representatives of this command.

Attached as Tab A is a proposed letter to the Department of Army transmitting budget defense data requested in radio WX 99387, 9 February 1950 (Tab B) for Project 412 (Japan) and Project 416 (Ryukyus). As indicated in the radio, one copy is to be mailed and original copy is to be handcarried by the budget group to Washington. 2. Data submitted includes the following, prepared separately for Japan and the Ryukyus. a. Listing of personnel currently earning \$7500 or more per year (Inclosures 1 and 2 to Tab A). b. Breakdown of positions by general fields of activity, and a breakdown of positions by grade classification and organizational segment. 3. Under items 2b, two separate sets of tabulations have been prepared for Japan. DA radio WX 99387 specifies that the tabulations should specifically tie in to 2018 positions (original green sheet estimates, less G-2 reductions and transfers to FSA and Dependent Schools transfer to Project 512), and a set of tabulations matching the 2018 figure has been prepared (Inclosure 3). Inasmuch as currently approved man-year ceilings for GARIOA activities in Japan total only 1794 positions (compared with the 2018 specified by the DA), including adequate reserve, G-1 considers it desirable to present the DA with current estimates of actual requirements (Inclosure 4). 4. The reorganization of RYCOM MG made the former data submitted to the DA almost completely obsolete. Therefore, only one set of tabulations, those reflecting most recent estimate of requirements (377 US and Filipino positions) has been prepared (Inclosure 5). 5. Revised green sheets, Japan and Ryukyus, have been stenciled and are being mimeographed. They will be available for the Budget Group to handcarry to Washington for the Congressional hearings, which it is understood have not yet been definitely scheduled. 6.
