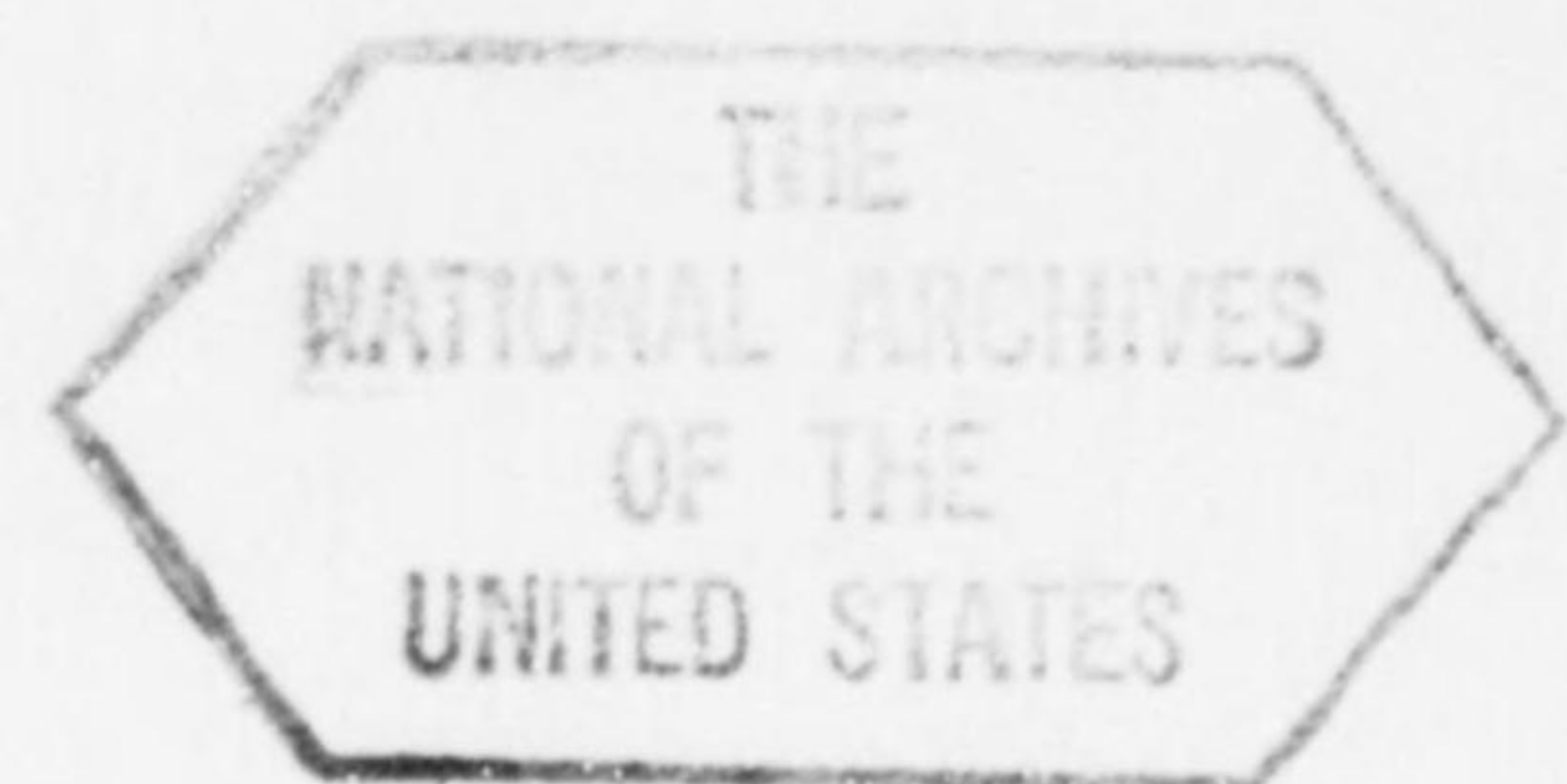



Telecommunications Establishment Law.

1. Objection is made to subject bill for failure to include a Bureau of Personnel. Such omission will, in the opinion of this Division, defeat an occupation objective by impairing the program and controls of the National Personnel Authority. For essential operation and controls, the National Personnel Authority must function through a personnel unit at the highest operating echelon within each agency.

2. It is recommended that Article 52 be revised to agree with the language used in corresponding provisions of other establishment laws as follows:

"Article 52. With respect to appointments, dismissals, promotions, disciplinary punishment, and other matters concerning personnel administration, the provisions of the National Public Service Law (Law No. 120 of 1947) shall apply."

2. This Section is unable, however, to concur in the recommendation of CCS that Government Section indicate to the Japanese Government SCAP's non-objection to the postponement "with the understanding that the Japanese Government entertains no reservations regarding the details of the reorganization as provided for in the law." Exaction of such commitment from the Japanese Government is believed to be contrary to the established policy of the Supreme Commander to permit the agencies of the Japanese Government to perform their constitutional duties without detailed control or intervention unless such control or intervention is necessary in order to safeguard or insure the attainment of some specific SCAP policy or objective. It is not apparent in the present instance that any change in the proposed reorganization which might be contemplated by the Japanese Government in the course of the general governmental reorganization necessitated by the present economy drive would violate or jeopardize any specific SCAP policy or objective. MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

On 4 March 1949 the undersigned in an interview with General Back pointed out that, in view of the Japanese Government's Cabinet resolution of 22 February 1949, effectuation of the law for reorganization of the Communications Ministry on 1 April 1949 would require the strongest kind of pressure from GHQ. Further, that such pressure might have to be backed up by a written directive, which could be issued only if it could be shown that postponement of the reorganization would violate or jeopardize some SCAP policy or objective. The undersigned proposed that the Japanese authorities be informed that there was no objection to the postponement but that they would be expected to carry out the separation of the postal and telecommunications services as indicated in General MacArthur's letter of 22 July 1948, and that the reorganization would follow in the main the functional outline provided in the present law. General Back agreed but requested that the undersigned discuss the matter with Mr. W. L. Wardell of CCS before notifying the Japanese.

On 5 March 1949 the undersigned conferred with Mr. Wardell but was unable to secure the latter's agreement to the proposed statement to the Japanese. Mr. Wardell maintained the position that the reorganization must follow in all details the present law which was worked out by the Japanese with the assistance and advice of CCS experts and represents the minimum which the Japanese must have if they are to build up an adequate telecommunications system.

On 7 March 1949 General Back, in an interview with General Whitney, was informed that Government Section could not support the CCS position because to do this would violate the SCAP principle of permitting the Japanese authorities to work out internal governmental and administrative matters with a minimum of control or intervention by the Occupation authorities. General Back was further advised that, unless the plan of reorganization as worked out by the CCS experts were clearly shown to carry out a SCAP objective, it should not be imposed upon the Japanese against their wishes but should be offered to them as the considered advice of the experts on the Supreme Commander's staff.

On 9 February 1949 Colonel Jay D. B. Lattin, in a conference with the undersigned, requested a written reply to the CCS Check Note No. (1), dated 4 March 1949, so that CCS might formulate its decision as to what further steps to take in the matter. Check Note No. (2) above sets forth the Government Section's position in writing as requested by Colonel Lattin.




