BOOKBINDER, employed at the Rand Development Corporation in NYC, had made inquiry of the American Embassy in Moscow, USSR, concerning subject. According to source, BOOKBINDER asked if WEBSTER's tour of the USSR was terminated. Source indicated that the US Embassy did not have knowledge of WEBSTER at that time but would check with "Intourist" and suggested that BOOKBINDER check at a later date.

[NY 1519-S*] advised on 10/5/59 Mr. FNU IBERALL, employee of the Rand Development Corporation, Cleveland, Ohio, was in contact with the American Embassy in Moscow, USSR, concerning the whereabouts of WEBSTER. According to source, IBERALL was advised WEBSTER had arrived in Leningrad, USSR.

[NY 1519-S*] advised on 10/5/59 GEORGE H. BOOKBINDER, Rand Development Corporation, NYC, was in contact with the American Embassy, Moscow, USSR. According to source, BOOKBINDER was advised that SAM CARDON, Rand Development Corporation employee, would handle the WEBSTER situation the rest of the way.
