VEHICULAR TRANSPORTATION FOR FOREIGN  
AND JAPANESE NATIONALS

1. Vehicular transportation is authorized for Foreign and Japanese National employees of this headquarters when such transportation is required in the performance of official duties. It is also authorized for non-occupation force personnel; e. g. representatives of the Japanese Government or commercial organizations, who are requested to accompany Department of Army Civilians of this headquarters in an official capacity.

a. Transportation for any reason other than that referred to above is not authorized. Circumstances which justify the use of Government transportation for reasons not included herein will be referred to the Deputy Chief.

2. a. Form attached as inclosure 1 will be accomplished on all Foreign and Japanese National employees who are required to travel by vehicular transportation in an official capacity.

b. Form attached as inclosure 2 will be accomplished on all Department of Army Civilian personnel who are accompanied by non-occupation force personnel while on official business.



TRAFFIC AND VEHICLE REGULATIONS

Administrative Memorandum Number 58, this headquarters, dated 6 August 1949, as amended by Administrative Memorandum Number 54, this headquarters, dated 19 May 1950, is further amended by deleting paragraph 14 b and substituting the following therefor:

\* \* \* \* \*

14. Forms Required to Operate Vehicles.

a. \*\*\* \*\* \*\*\*\*

"b. In case the operator of a privately owned motor vehicle is other than the owner or a person named on the Registration Form as an authorized operator of such vehicle, such operator, except dependents, shall have in his possession, in addition to the documents required by (1), (2) and (3) above, a Letter of Authority signed by the owner of the vehicle, a copy of which will be filed with the Area Provost Marshal. No letter of authorization is required where the vehicle is being operated by a dependent of the registered owner. The said letter will contain:

- (1) Make, type, and year of vehicle.
- (2) JAFOC license number of vehicle.
- (3) Name and address of person or persons authorized to operate the vehicle.
- (4) Statement that the owner assumes full financial responsibility in case of liability for accident or violation of regulations.
- (5) Statement of the owner that personnel authorized to operate the vehicle, other than the owner or members of his family, will operate it on a bona-fide loan basis, without compensation, and that such personnel possess a proper permit to operate a motor vehicle.

Provided, however, that no such copy of the letter need be filed with the Provost Marshal in cases where the operator has received permission to operate the vehicle on a one-time temporary basis."

CHANGES IN TRAFFIC CIRCULATION AND PARKING REGULATIONS

1. Changes in present Traffic Regulations in the Area bounded by Konya-bashi Canal, on the north, 10th Street on the south, 10th Street on the east, and 5th Street on the west, will become effective 15 May 1950.

2. Changes in area south of "Z" Avenue.

a. Parking:

- (1) The unnamed street running east and west between Annex Avenue and Utility Avenue, and which is located three (3) blocks south of the Main Post Exchange, is restricted to one side of the street.
- (2) Utility Avenue, restricted to one side of the Street. (Utility Avenue is located four (4) blocks south of the Post Exchange)
- (3) Ginza Street from "Z" Avenue, released to public parking.

3. Changes in area north of "Z" Avenue.

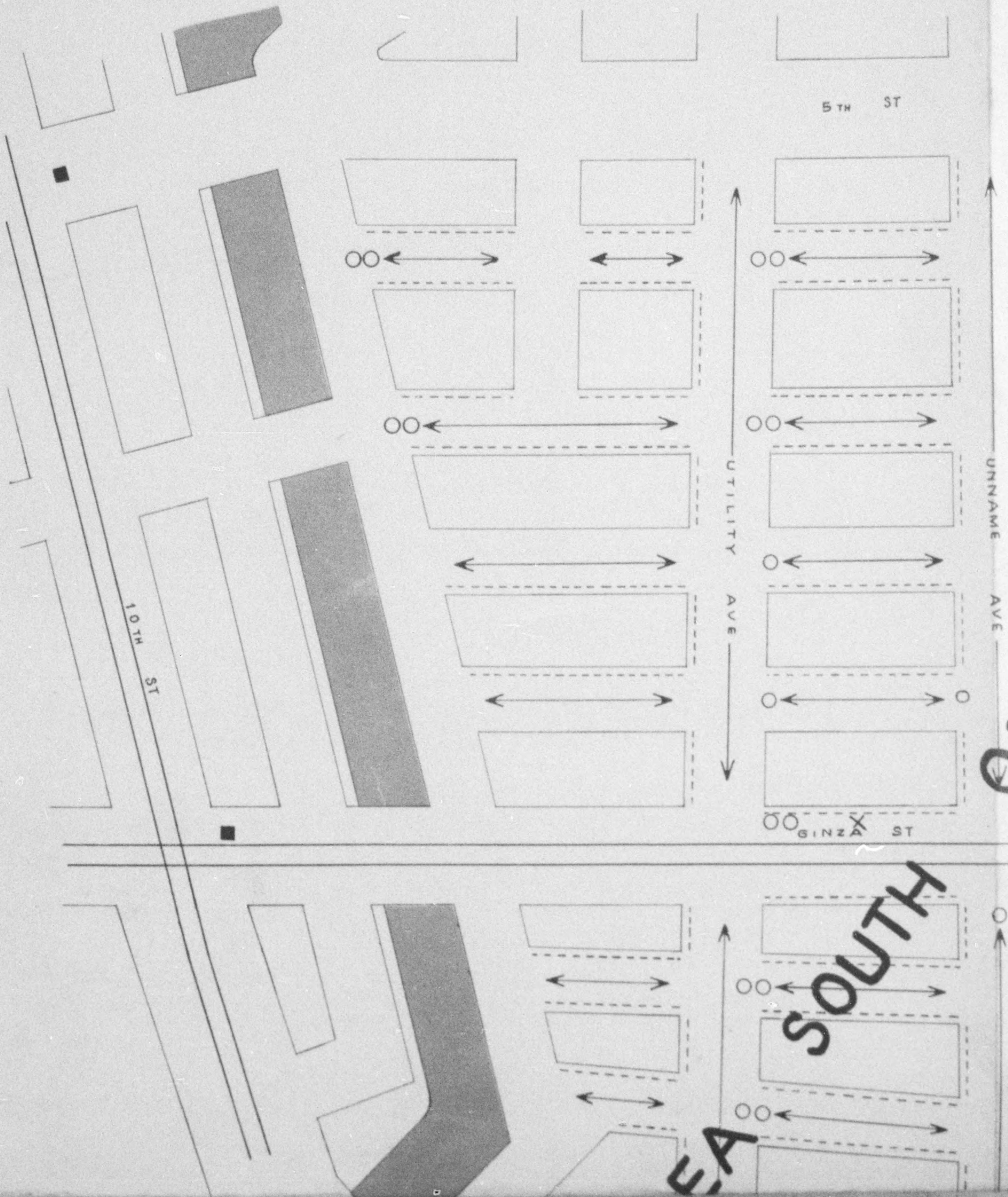
a. Directional flow of Traffic:

- (1) St Lukes Avenue, one way with traffic moving from east to west in the direction of 5th Street.
- (2) Right turns prohibited between the hours of 1200 and 1700 at the intersection of St Lukes and Ginza Street, and the intersection of Ginza and Exchange Street. (Corner of Main Post Exchange)

b. Parking:

- (1) Ginza Street from Exchange Street to "Z" Avenue.
- (2) The Center Area two (2) blocks east of the Post Exchange on 10th Street available to P.X. customers. Signs will be posted at Post Exchange directing P.X. customers to this parking area.
