CHAPUT RELATED THIS SOURCE SAID TWENTY EIGHT INDIVIDUALS SCHEDULED PARTICIPATE IN INVASION AGAINST CUBA, BUT FIORINI HIMSELF WOULD NOT GO. TWO M DASH ONE RIFLES AND TWO CARBINES WERE SHOWN TO THIS SOURCE BY FIORINI, AND SOURCE SAID THESE MEN ARE BEING TRAINED IN RIFLE PRACTICE IN THE EVERGLADES. TODAY ROBERT BREWSTER REGIONAL DIRECTOR, US BORDER PATROL, MIAMI ADVISED EXTENSIVE INVESTIGATION BEING AFFORDED THIS MATTER BY BORDER PATROL, AND US CUSTOMS, MIAMI, HAS BEEN ADVISED OF PERTINENT INFO. BREWSTER SAID BORDER PATROL AND CUSTOMS WILL TAKE NECESSARY ACTION IN EVENT FIORINI-S GROUP ATTEMPTS DEPART US.
