Special attention is directed to SR 711-45-1 which contains detailed instructions covering the preparation of these reports and changes 2 and 3 thereof which contain a complete list of Engineer and Medical Service items, respectively together with nomenclature, stock numbers, and line item numbers. The basic objective in the preparation of this report is to arrive at the total number of each Engineer and Medical Service item within this Command. Care must be exercised to avoid duplication in the reporting of items. The general rule established is that items will be reported only by the unit or activity that holds accountability for them. Items that are held on memorandum receipt from an accountable officer or another unit or activity will not be reported. Accountable supply officers will report all items that they have issued on memorandum receipt together with items in warehouse stocks. Units will report all items other than those held on memorandum receipt.


