PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE ORDINANCE

Prime Minister's Office Ordinance No. 19

October 25, 1947

Prime Minister's Office Ordinance No. 11, 1947 shall be partially revised as follows:

Prime Minister

KATAYAMA Tetsu

The following proviso shall be added to Paragraph

3 of Supplementary Provisions:

The Director-General of Price Board, in case he deems it necessary, may order the persons who retain the Price Equilibrium Fund in accordance with the provision mentioned in Paragraph 1 of Article 6 or Paragraph 1 of Article 7 of the old Ordinance (before revision of July 12, 1947) to pay all or part of that Fund to the National Treasury.

The following one paragraph shall be added next to Paragraph 3 of Supplementary Provisions:

The amount of money to be paid to the National Treasury under the proviso of the preceding paragraph shall be paid in accordance with a payment notification issued by the Director-General of Price Board.

Supplementary Provision:

This Prime Minister's Office Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation.
