Article 15 shall be amended as follows:

Article 15. Even in case the number of conversation units is decreased according to the provisions of Article 58-(3) of the Telephone Regulations applied mutatis mutandis under the provisions of Article 19-(3) or the provisions of Article 18 paragraph 3, the rate for press subscribed call shall not be reduced for one year after opening of the service.
