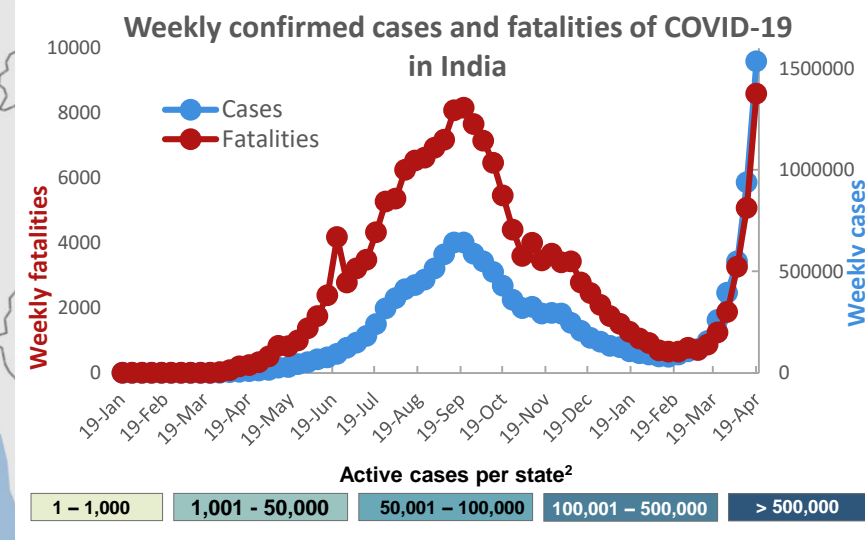
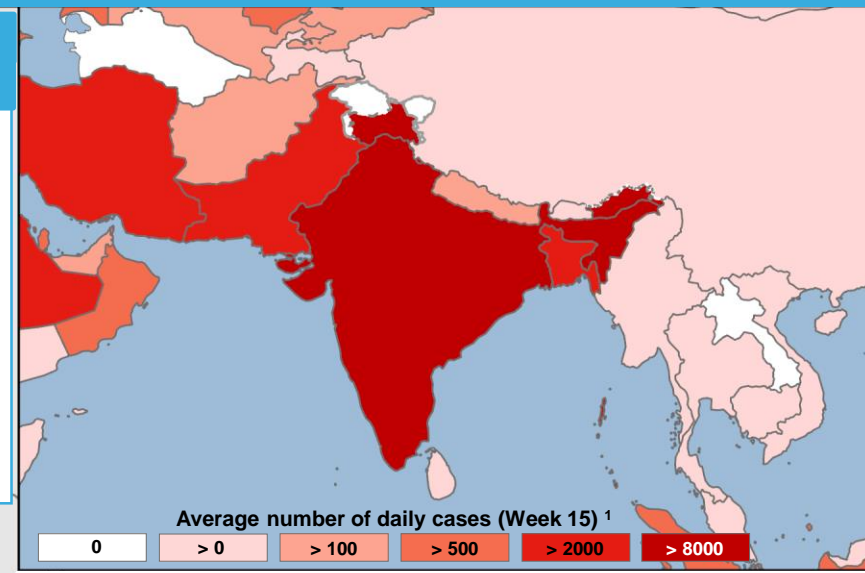


### UCPM RESPONSE

On 23 April the Union Civil Protection Mechanism (UCPM) was activated to support India in its response to Covid-19. The requests cover liquid oxygen (and related required appliances), ventilators and medicines used in the treatment of COVID-19.

So far, offers have been made by Belgium, Finland, Ireland, Luxembourg, Portugal, Romania, and Sweden. Other EU Member States and UCPM Participating States are preparing additional offers.

Assets offered so far include: oxygen concentrators, cylinders and generators, ventilators, and medicines (Remdesivir).
