Beginning at the intersection of present U.S. Route 84 and U.S. Route 19 east of Thomasville, then northerly for 2.8 miles to the intersection of a new facility, then westerly over the new facility for 4.8 miles to the intersection of present U.S. Route 84. Redesignate present U.S. Route 84 between the intersection of U.S. Route 19 east of Thomasville and the intersection of U.S. Route 19 Business in Thomasville as U.S. Route 84 Business. Also designate present U.S. Route 19 Business between the intersection of present U.S. Route 84 in Thomasville and the intersection of proposed U.S. Route 84 just north of Thomasville as U.S. Route 84 Business. Also, eliminate the present U.S. Route 19 Business designation in the Thomasville areas.
