該約之人民國三年中英藏在印度 Simla 地方會議該著者又任英國全權代表之藏 三十年英軍侵藏之時該著者嘗奉英國政府之命選擇適宜地段爲建築印藏鐵路之 八年。此項政治委員之職責係在代表英國關於哲孟雄西藏布坦等地之利益光緒 用其後並任英軍所佔職地之行政長官宣統二年英國之合併布坦該著者實為手訂 著者 Bell曾任英國駐紮哲孟雄之政治委員者十年(自一九〇八年至一九一

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界者前後總計十有九年之久實為英國之『西藏通』因此彼所著之西藏之今昔 藏文法並編輯英藏字典一册民國九年英國政府復請其再任駐哲政治委員是年因 事顧問民國七年該著者辭去英國駐哲政治委員之職退居大吉嶺增改彼之二版西 書在歐洲甚有名德國方面於該書出版之次年(一九二五年)即已將其譯為德文 教迎(光緒三十二年彼並曾受班禪喇嘛之招請前往日喀則)該著者居於印藏邊 達賴喇嘛之屢次邀請該著者遂以外交代表名義前往拉薩逗留一年之久備受藏人

字樣而中國方面除外交部出版之英文條約彙編價昂不易購買外關於此類條約之 中英藏會議解決四藏問題止不但對於研究中國近代外交留心解決西藏懸案之人, 文一一附錄於後以資比較蓋條約之中往往註明『如有疑義時以英文爲標準』之 照該約漢文原文抄錄並未另譯外其餘八篇皆由余譯自英文並將十三篇之英文原 甚有價值即對於專治古史者亦當不乏與趣其中除(五)(六)(七)(八)(十)五篇係 書所譯文件十三篇係自唐代宗廣德元年吐蕃人寇長安一役起至民國三年

誦讀英文五十故事等等不如誦閱條約原文之爲善也。 條約大全於本書所譯各篇亦多未會載入此外余以為吾國法政學生學習英文與其 英文原文殊不易得其實不但英文原文殊不易得而已卽商務書館出版之漢文國際

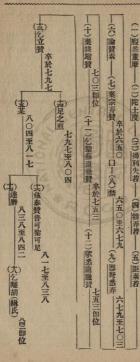

名為蘇爾喀者位於尼泊爾京城克提門都 Katmandu 之西北至一七六九年蘇爾喀 …當(西歷)第十八世紀上半期之際尼泊爾方面許多小王國之中曾有一國 泊爾得於拉薩方面置一常駐代表此外西藏更當每年繳納一萬盧比而且廓人在藏 下之盟而還麻爾略於他種條件之外必須每五年遺派進貢專使前往北京一次…… 駐藏中之寧軍交戰數次將其打敗最後(長追直入)距離廓京只有數里之遙爲城 手遣派華藏合組之大軍一隊於是年冬季取道西藏前進並於一七九二年春間與留 生時疫因而大部分軍隊及其軍官不得不退回本國藏人之中嘗將此次時疫稱為神 還後因進貢一事未曾履行之故廊爾略又於一七九一年佔據西藏大城日喀則 其後彼此訂立密約(四藏方面)允許每年進貢若干於是廓爾略復將所佔地 國家一七八八年廓爾喀又藉口多端直將西藏領地之與尼泊爾接壤者佔領數處但 會長途將尼泊爾全部置於勢力範圍之下未幾此項好戰民族復將目光移向西藏方 之譴責中國政府對於前此廓軍進攻之事固未嘗一接中國駐藏代表報告現在始着 八五五年廊爾略復為第二次之侵入其理由則為藏人虐待廓僑戰事結果遂許尼 一七八四年該族遂向哲孟雄進攻而其時哲孟雄乃係對於西藏政府每年進貢之 該城與班禪行宮 Tashilhunpo 相距僅有兩里之遙惟其時鄭軍方面忽然發

至於英國之所以取銷派 北京條約之中 引起無數困難之故於是英人終將此項計畫打消在上述一八八六年七月二十四日 印度方面派遣一種限於商業目的之遠征隊前往西藏但因西藏居民所持態度勢將 方面時常設法運動該道開放但均無效一八七六年之煙臺條約誠然許可英人得從 國西藏政府曾得中國政府之同意將哲孟雄北方大道封鎖其後數年之間印度政府 事實特別加以聲明中國政府應資責在西藏居民方面促進與印通商事件云云 ……哲孟雄一國本爲西藏喇嘛治下之附庸因此該國遂間接的成爲中國 (光所按即光緒十二年六月二十三日中英所訂緬甸條約) 督對於 遣遠征除到藏並將經營西藏計畫加以擱置者當係英國對
