

Interviewed Shigeo Masuda the president. No production report has ever been filed. Masuda believed it not necessary to file one. Production of kettles was 2200 in excess and pots 1300 in excess of allotted number granted for one month by permit. Filters are not allowed to be made and no attempts have been made to secure a permit for their production.

Production of filters was stopped until a permit is granted. Production of kitchen utensils to drop to allotted number each month or was threatened to have factory closed.

Production report will be filed in a few days.
