Chapter 161 (December 30, 1934)

I saw the Minister who said to me: "I am going to give out a statement explaining the circumstances of Japan's abrogation of the Washington Treaty and also her intrinsic desire for naval disarmament so that we may have the world understand Japan's true intentions. In any case, around March next year various questions will crop up. Therefore we have got first of all to keep a sharp and careful watch on China's attitude. But at the same time we have to note the fact that the powers are apprehensive lest Japan should, on her abrogation of the Naval Disarmament Treaty, deal with China in her own free way. With a view to dispelling their misgivings, I would like to have some treaty concluded with China through direct negotiations with her thereby evincing forcibly the security of China's territorial integrity and clarifying Japan's true attitude therein."
