All bomba landed in the target area with excellent coverage, but the extent of the damage done could not be determined. The area was also well covered by straring. Meager and inaccurate small arms fire was received but none of our planes was hit. On return to base, flight became low on gas and was forced to land at Malabang, Mindanao at 1030 to refuel, taking off again at 1100.
