




- The root of the differences in our understanding of the Movement Charter's purpose *seems to be* how precisely we expect it to guide the Movement's actions.





- ➤ Possible further appointments to fill expertise gaps


Rationale

- The group needs to have focus on expertise not on popularity
- ➤ Equity does not happen by itself, it needs to be supported by the process
- ➤ Need to build the Charter for the future of our Movement

Proposal: pros and cons
