<u>Kissinger:</u> Demirel is in a tough position because Ecevit has all the leftists. And Erbakan is a wild man.

Caglayangil told me they would go to great lengths to make progress in Brussels.

President: Is he from Demirel's party?

<u>Kissinger</u>: Yes. [described the Turkish parties] Ecevit wants a new election. Demirel wants to wait until his economic program gets going. We can trust Demirel. He is a good friend--Ecevit less so. Caglayangil promised, and when they promise they de liver.

President: I like Demirel -- there's no bullshit with him.

Kissinger: And they can't get into their heads why there is an embargo on them.

President: We can't agree to Greek aid before the embargo lifts.

<u>Kissinger</u>: Our compromise would be to drop the grant and continue the sales. That would give Brademas a face-saver.
