 - Free speech
 - To be an amateur act as a lover
 - Motivation: Recognition by:
 - Love (Attribution, etc...)
 - And/or money

2.1: "Libre is not gratis" - Stallman

- ~1984: Stallman creates Copyleft
- ~1994: "Libre Software", 2001: "FLOSS"
- 2011-14: LibreOffice implements ISO ODF-family standard with many libre artworks recognizing developers by attribution and money. Stallman says: "Libre is not gratis".

2.2: Web2

- ~2004: Web2 goes mainstream
- All netizens = authors
- They can spread the culture of humanity in near equality.
- Wolna kultura on Wikipedia, Commons, DUDH (UDHR, "PDPC") is the first work on Wikisource

- 2.3: Last 10 years of Libre Repositories examples
- Wikimedia Commons accepts Ogg Vorbis, Speex & FLAC audio files & Theora >1 video files since 2008.
- Mutopia, IMSLP, later Commons accept music score source code & PDF
- As Commons accepts PDF-s, Gutenberg, Wikisource accept music and literature open sources.
