From the latter half of 1938, the Company only had the staff of about 20 including both Tokyo and Osaka Branches, on account of the business depression, e. g. the chief of the Business Dept. held the post of Manager of the Osaka Branch additionally, and the "Department" was only in name because a chief and 1 or 2 members were in charge of each department.
