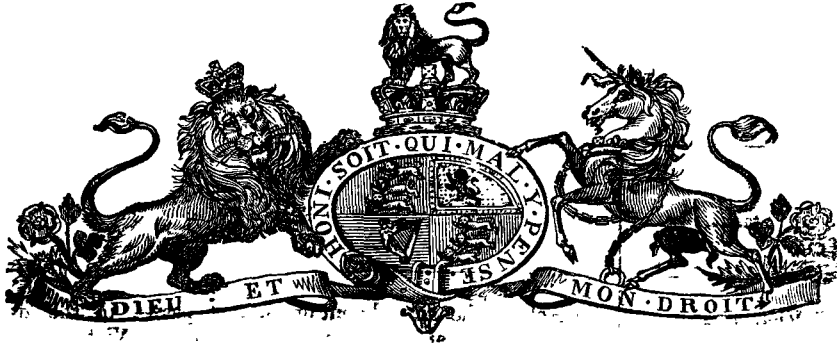

AN ACT for bringing into operation within the Colony certain Acts of the Imperial Parliament.
[27th October, 1860.]

Title.

WHEREAS certain Acts of the Imperial Parliament specified in the Schedule hereunto annexed have been passed for the Amendment of the Law, and it is expedient that the same be adopted and brought into operation within the Colony :

Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand, in Parliament assembled, and by authority of the same, as follows :

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be the "English Acts Act, 1860."

Short Title.

II. The several Acts of the Imperial Parliament specified in the Schedule hereunto annexed, shall be taken to extend to this Colony, and shall be applied therein in the administration of justice in like manner as Acts of Parliament passed before the establishment of the Colony are applied.

Certain Acts adopted.

English Acts.

III. The Statute 15 Vic., c. 24, shall be deemed and taken to have been in force on and after the 31st day of December, in the year 1854.
