Redesignation will necessitate republication of all directives of this headquarters; render present stock of stationery obsolete; require retitling of all vehicles; add to administrative costs; and overtax staff of these headquarters which was cut fifty (50) per cent upon recent consolidation. Recent assumption of PHILCOM authorities and responsibilities by PHILAIRCOM given wide publicity by radio and press. Change of title will require new publicity program as well as advice of such change to administrative, operational, and logistical authorities superior and subordinate to and servicing this command. Continuance of PHILAIRCOM as command designation is recommended.

NOTE FOR RECORD:

1. FEAF msg AX 3118 Com 3 requested information as to the communication facilities which will be required for Army use in the Philippines. Plan to dispatch a communications Engineering Team to the Philippines to reengineer, prepare and publish Air Force projects.

2. The logistic responsibilities for the PHILAIRCOM Designate are outlined in Operations Instructions No 8 and communications responsibilities were implemented by CINCPAC msg CX 51356 and CX 51339. These msgs outline the projects which should be redesignated as Air Force projects and contained many details which would be difficult to indicate in correspondence. In addition, requirements may have changed and could only be indicated by CG PHILCOM and CG PHILAIRCOM Designate.

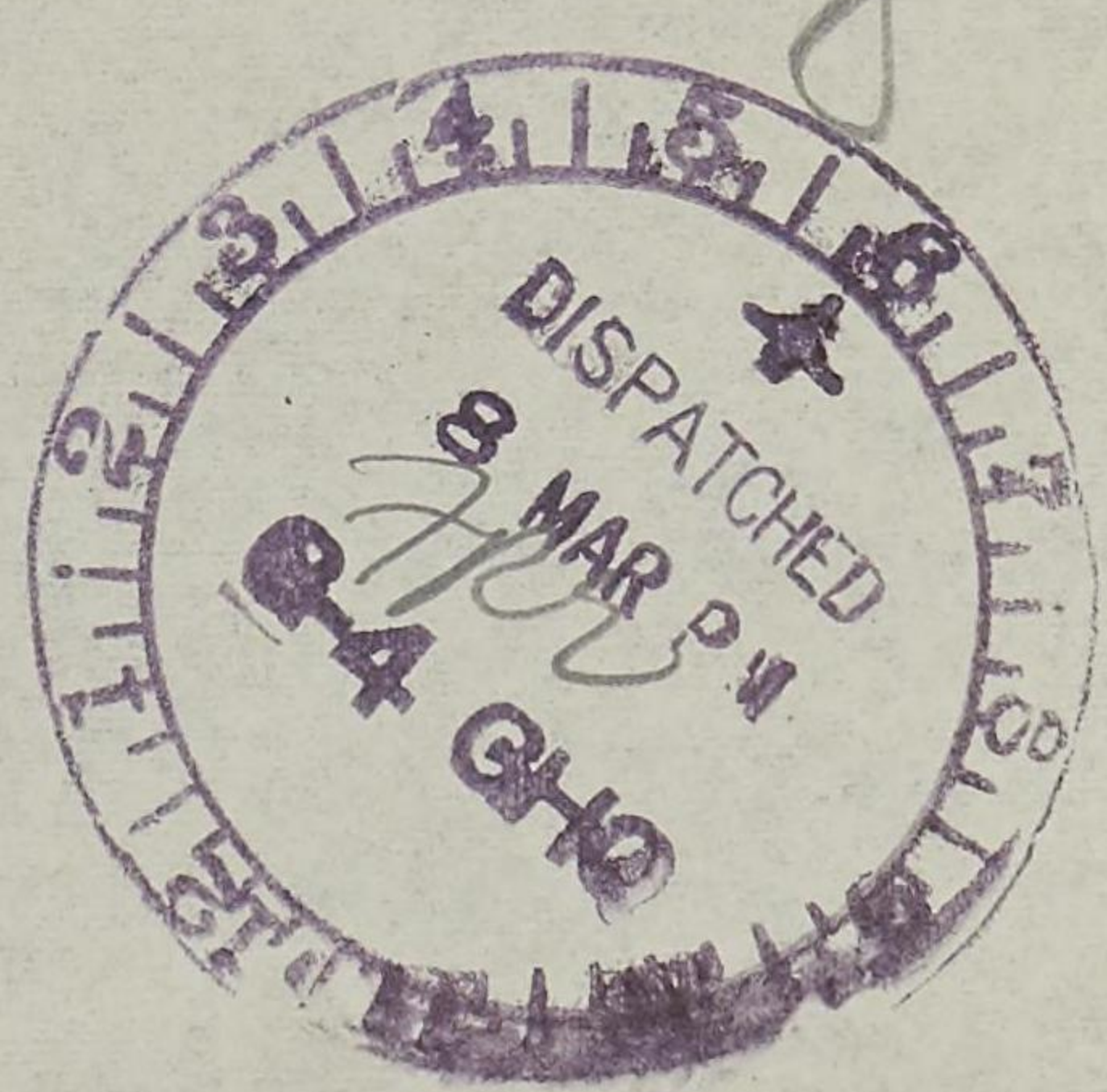

5. Action completed on G-4 Journal No. 78154.

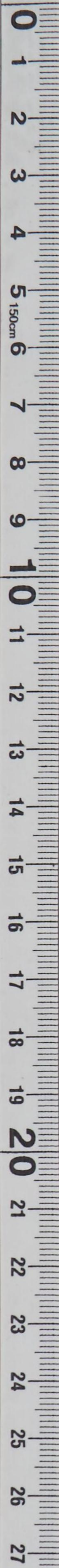

1. Reference correspondence with PHILCOM on this subject, including incoming Routine PHILCOM message G-25844, dated 24 February 1949, and discussion with your office, increases both my distrust of the alleged requirement figures and of the availability of funds to complete the roll-up.

2. There seems to be an unwarranted willingness to accept the fact that equipment is in the hands of troops as a reason for not having an exact inventory of its quantity, technical condition and tonnage. This implies that troops are not required to keep property records; that reasonable technical inspections are not being made and that troops are not fit to take the field because they do not know one of the basic logistic factors - what is needed to move their equipment. The other implication is that poor supply discipline is permitting troops to retain equipment they should not have.
