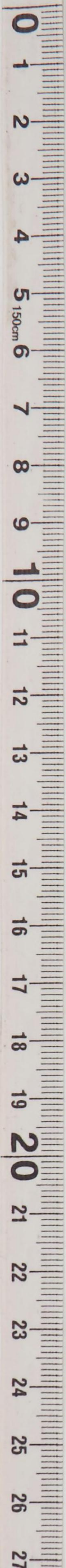

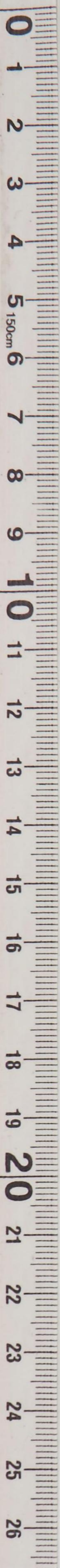

MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD:

SUBJECT: Petition for Release from Procurement Demand

1. The Problem. ESS requested by C/N that G-4 take necessary action on a petition to release part of the Tsukiji Center of Tokyo-to Central Wholesale Market.

2. References. a. C/N (1), ESS to G-4, subject as above, 11 May 1950.

b. Petition from ^aJapanese for release of procured facility, 9 May 1950.

3. Discussion of Facts. a. Reference 2a transmitted this petition to G-4 as a matter of primary interest.

b. (1) Reference 2b was hand-carried to ESS by the Chairman of the Filipino-Japanese Cultural Association. Petition requests release of the 12,979 tsubo (467,244 sq ft) now held by occupation forces. Reasons advanced stressed need for the space due to greatly increased population and necessity for more space for handling foodstuffs to supply Tokyo population.

(2) Occupation force use of the 12,979 tsubo is as follows:

(a)	2,322 tsubo	= Carpentry & Laundry Sect
(b)	3,979 tsubo	= Motor Pool
(c)	451 tsubo	= Refrigerator Plant
(d)	1,025 tsubo	= Motor Pool
(e)	4,642 tsubo	= Motor Pool
(f)	560 tsubo	= Warehouse Space
Total	= 12,979 tsubo	

Policy setting procedure of processing petitions from Japanese Nationals for the return of any type of real estate was established by the following and stated in effect that all petitions would be screened thru the Japanese Government to determine their importance.

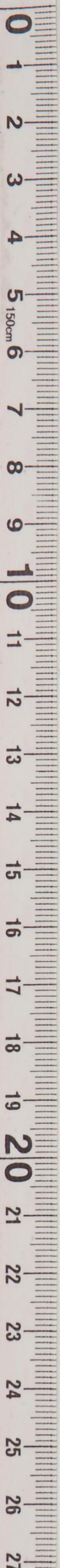
