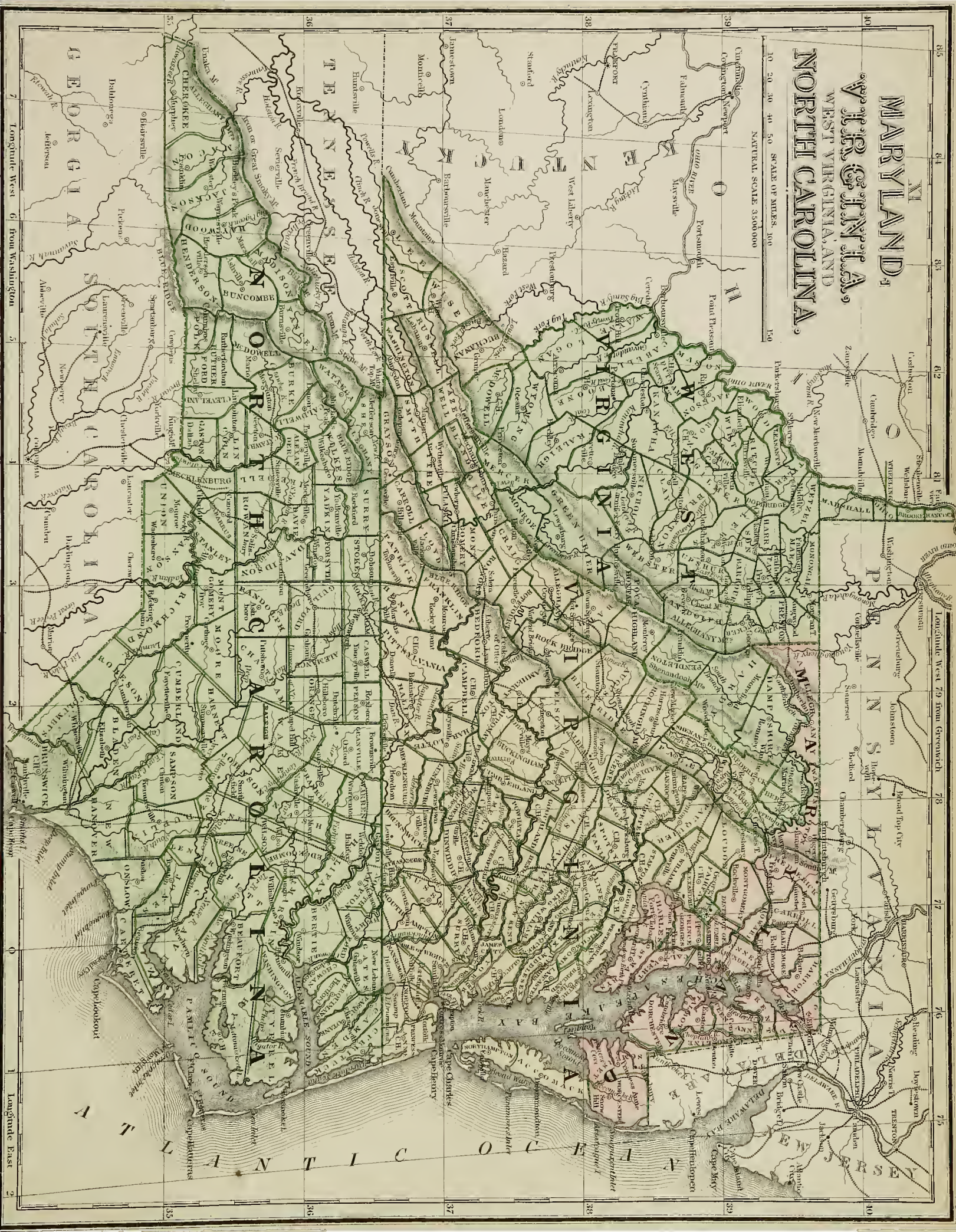






# MARYLAND, WEST VIRGINIA, AND NORTH CAROLINA.

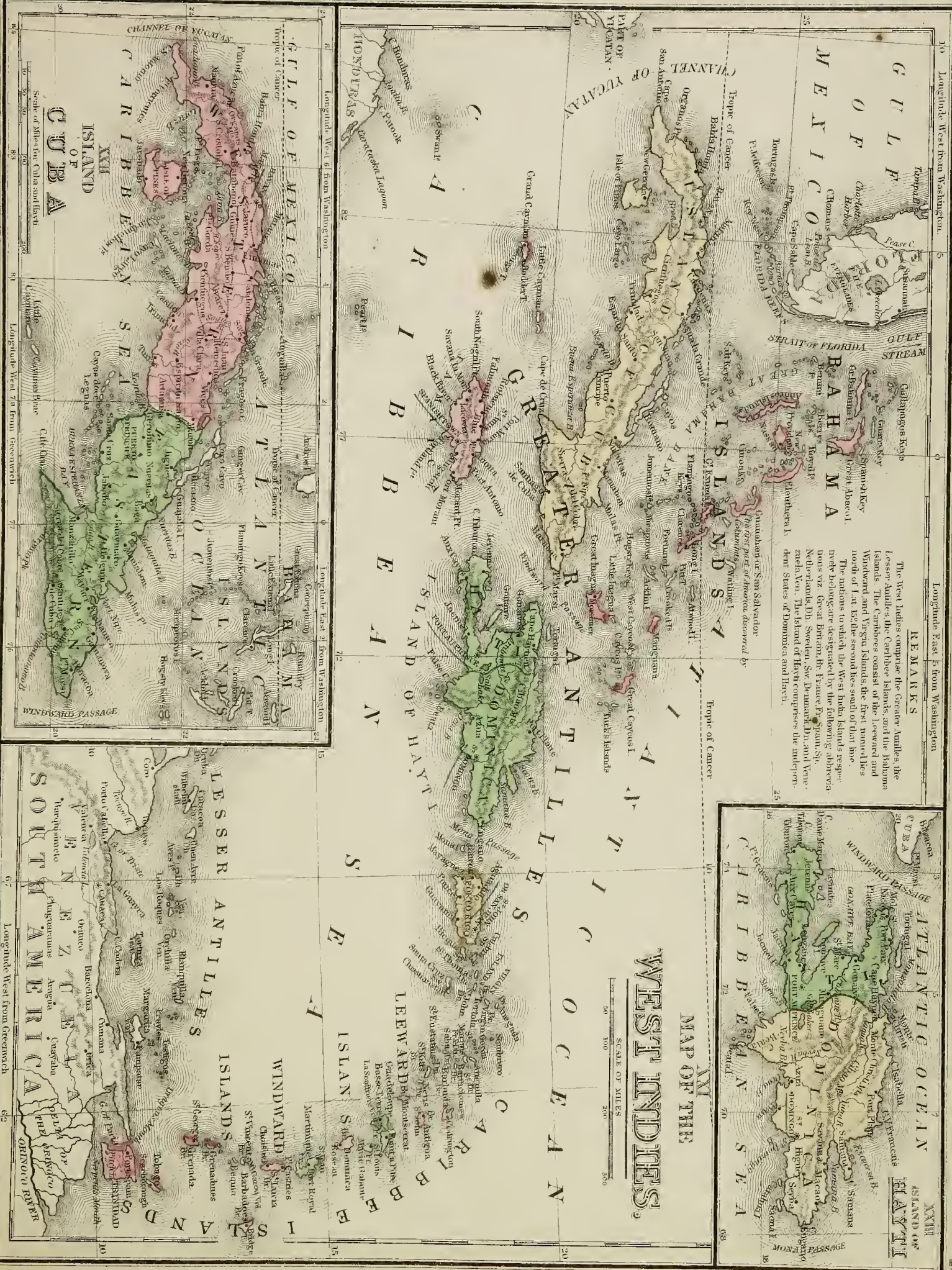
REMARKS

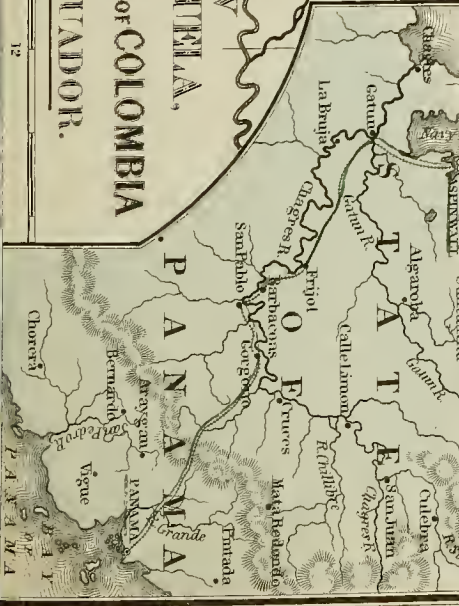

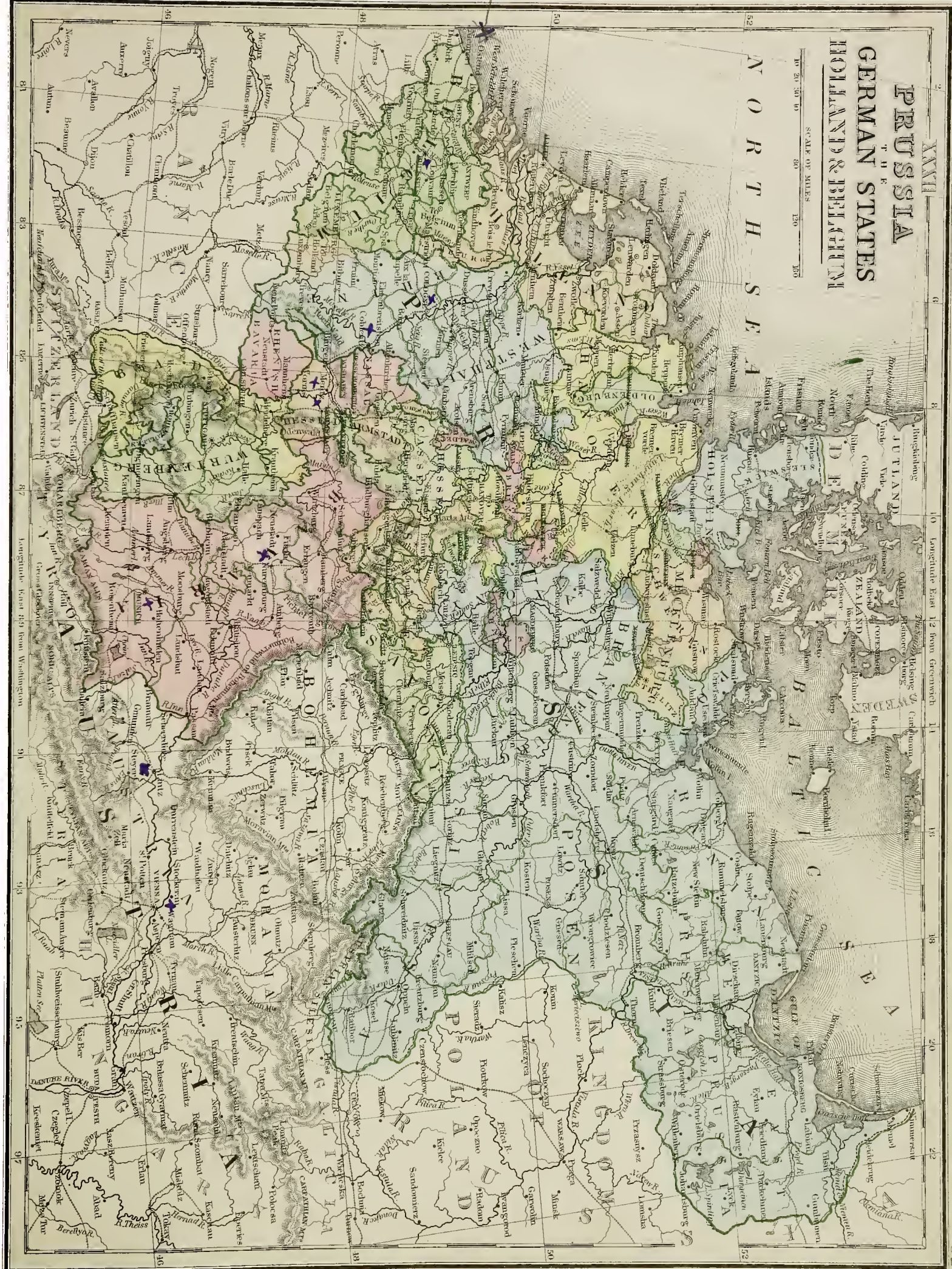




# PRUSSIA GERMAN STATES HOLLAND & BELGIUM

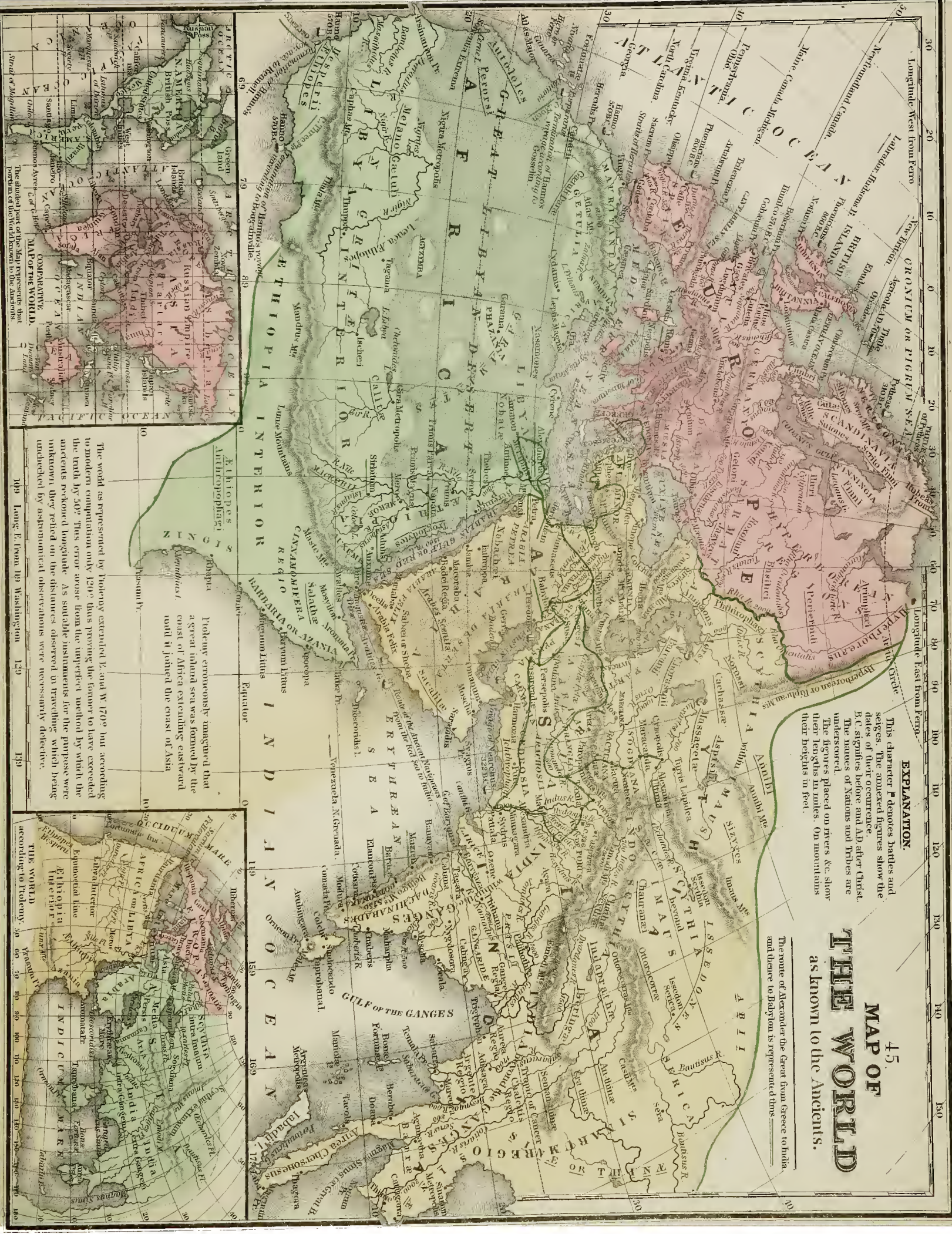


# THE WORLD as known to the Ancients.

The route of Alexander the Great from Greece to India and thence to Babylon is represented thus —

### EXPLANATION.

This character P denotes battles and sieges. The annexed figures show the dates of their occurrence. B.C. signifies before and A.D. after Christ. The names of Nations and Tribes are underscored. The figures placed on rivers &c. show their lengths in miles. On mountains their heights in feet.



Proteus erroneously imagined that a great inland sea was formed by the coast of Africa extending eastward until it joined the coast of Asia

The world as represented by Ptolemy extended E. and W. 170° but according to modern computation only 120° thus proving the former to have exceeded the truth by 50°. This error arose from the imperfect method by which the ancients reckoned longitude. As suitable instruments for the purpose were unknown they relied on the distances observed in travelling which being undecided by astronomical observations were necessarily defective.

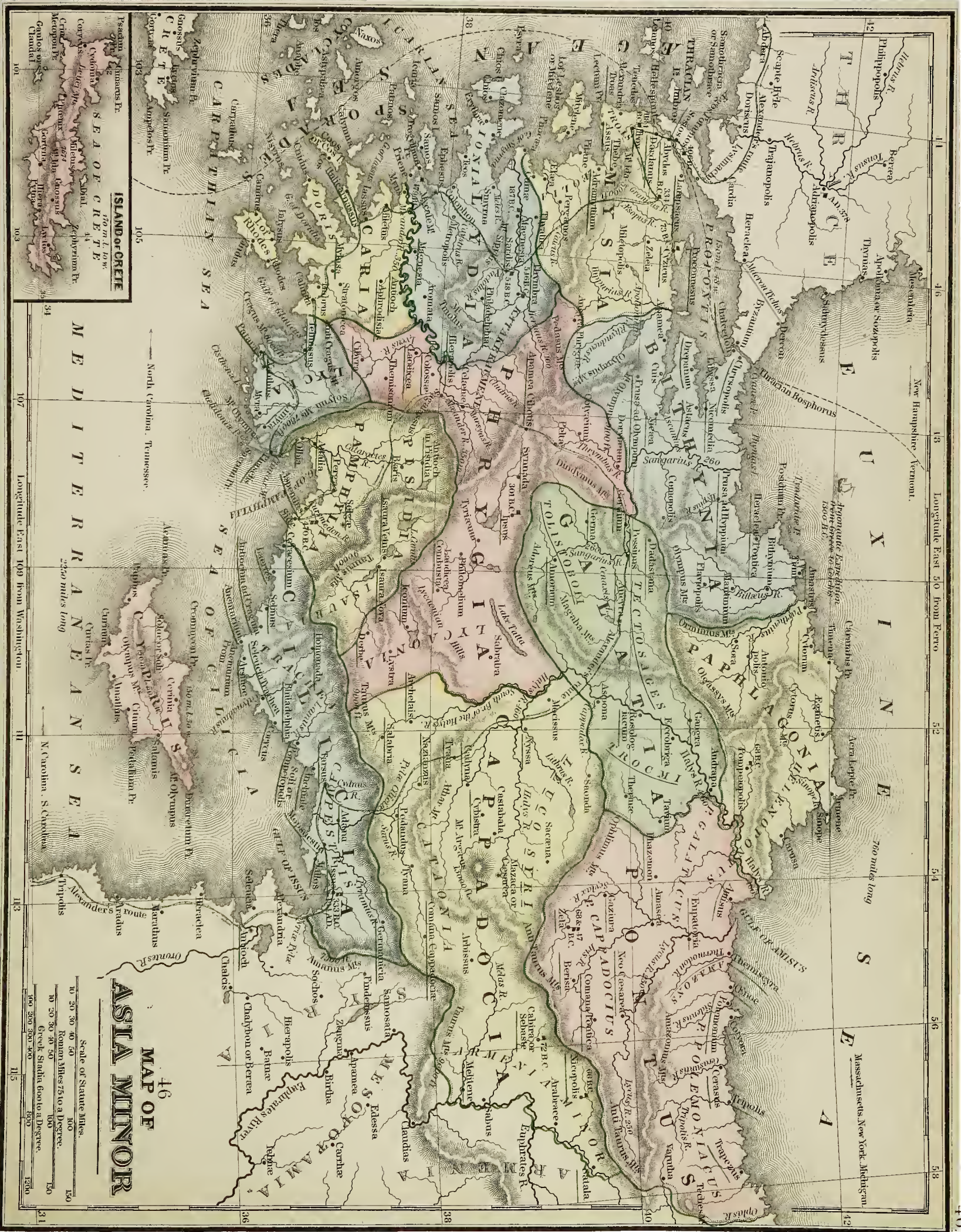

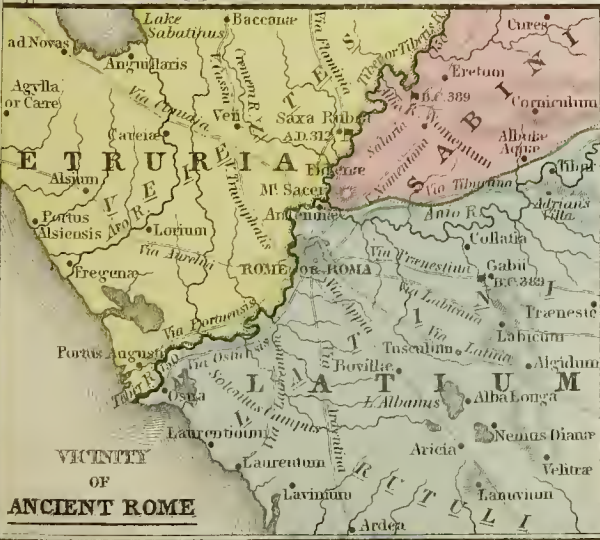
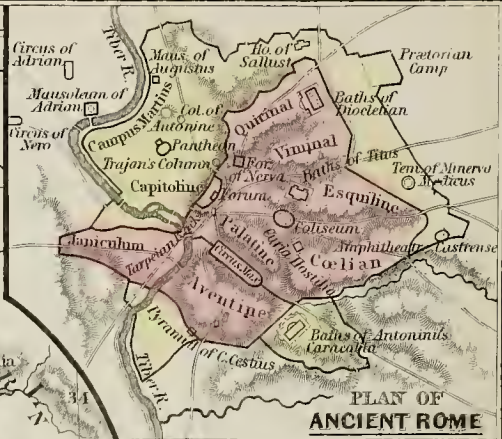












**MAP OF ANCIENT ITALY**
