Frats Meet At CCGM

The Gardner-Harper commission, developed to better relations between the University and the community, held its second meeting Thursday.

Ken Gardner, one of the committee's sponsors, said the purpose of the meeting was to "air problems between the city and students."

"This is a great idea," said Coral Gables Mayor Robert Knight. "It's something we've needed for a long time. Some where along the line we have to have some one to talk to."

The familiar community

complaints of too much noise from the fraternities, along with parking and traffic problems were voiced.

"It is important to note," Gardner said, "that the community and the University have common complaints. One example is that of early morning trash collection. The Mayor had received complaints from Gables residents and the campus about the early morning noise."

"We do have problems," said Knight. "Every day I get complaints about some of the fraternities that are pretty raucous. But the residents and the students have been too much apart from each

This is to advise you of several appointments related to the Gardner-Harper Commission, which were recently agreed upon.


