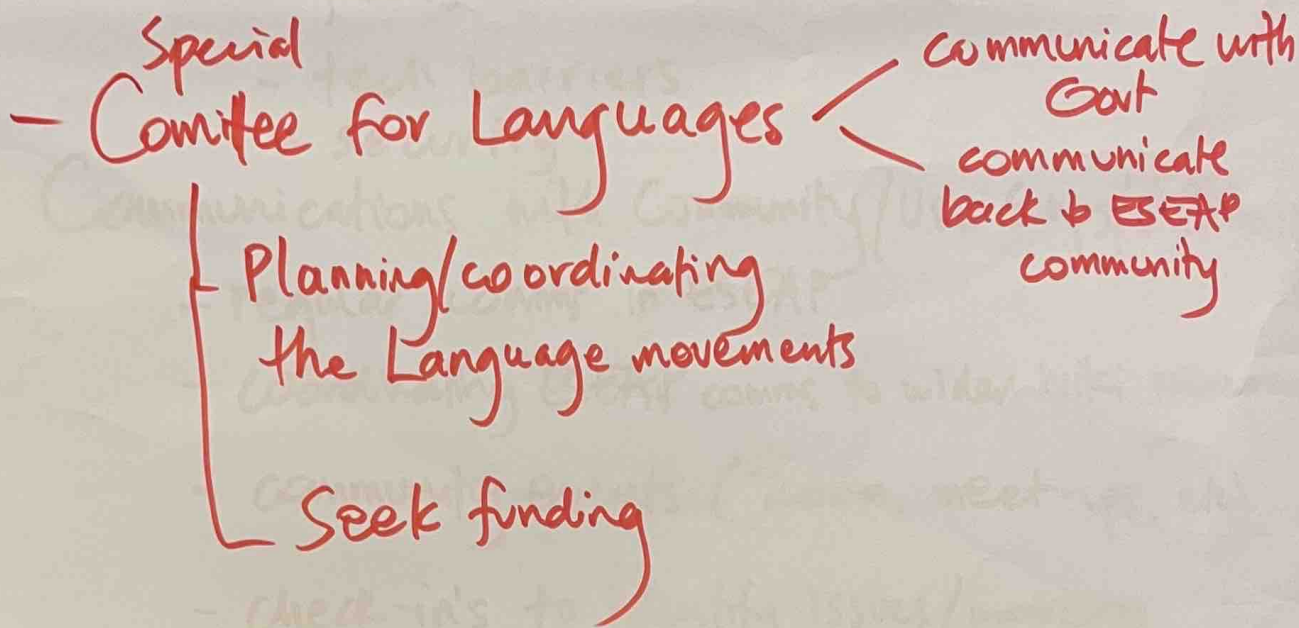
What are the roles the ESEAP Hub needs?

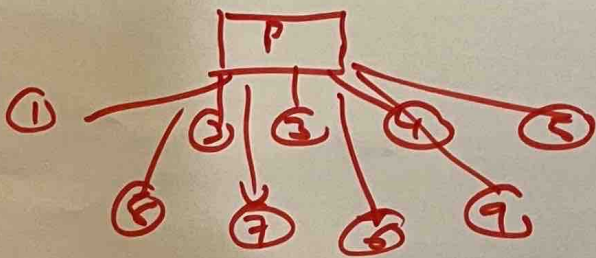
