



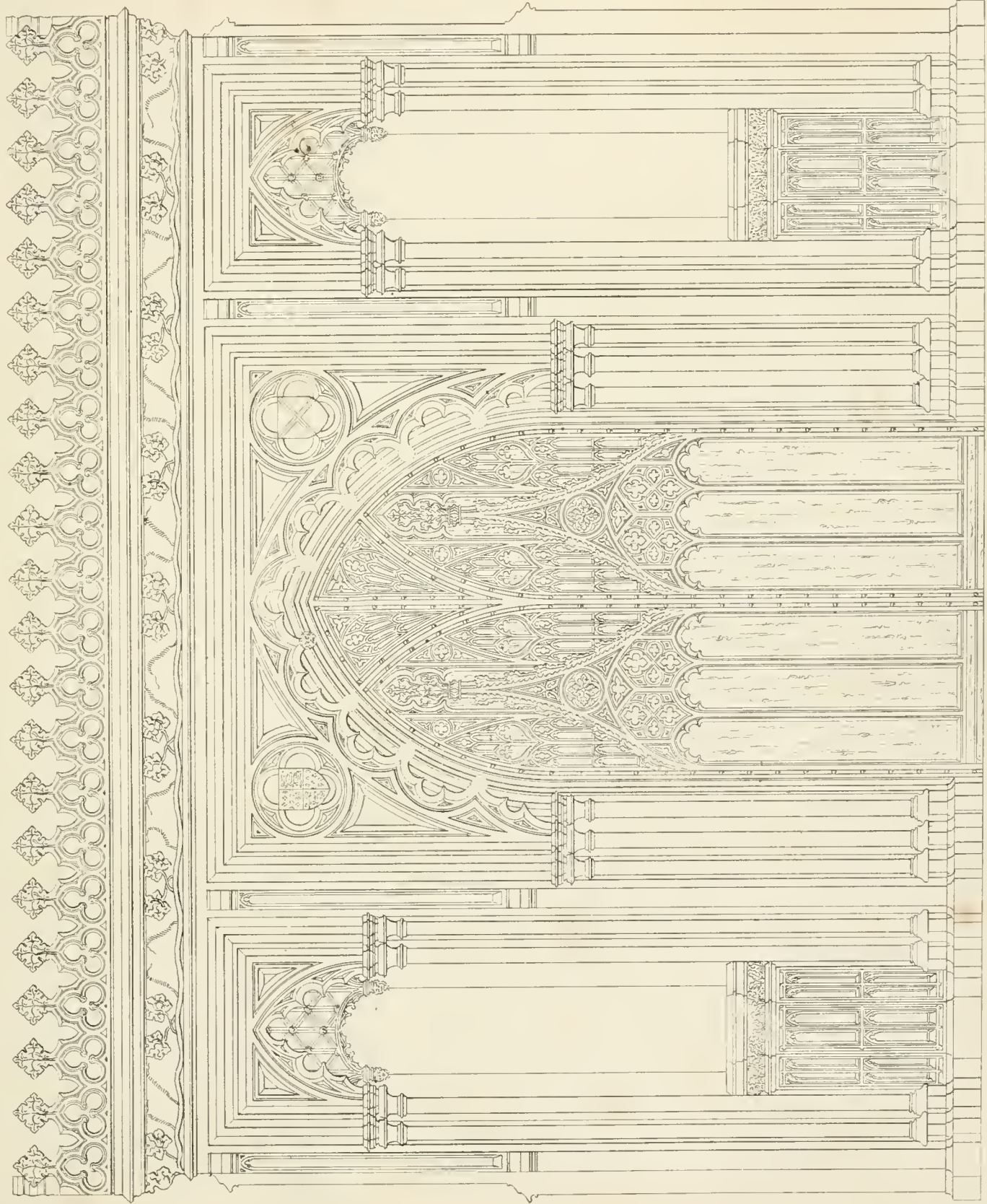

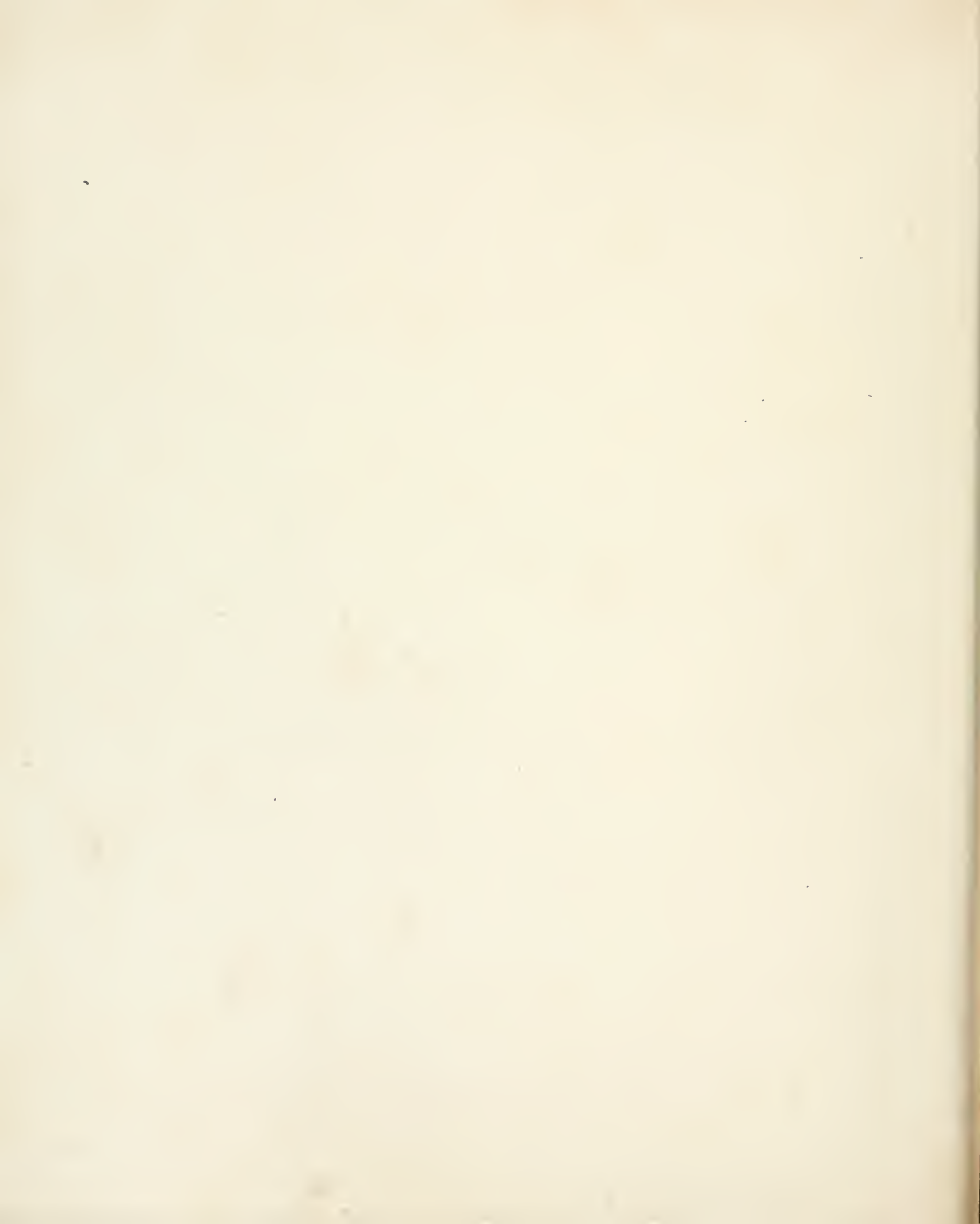

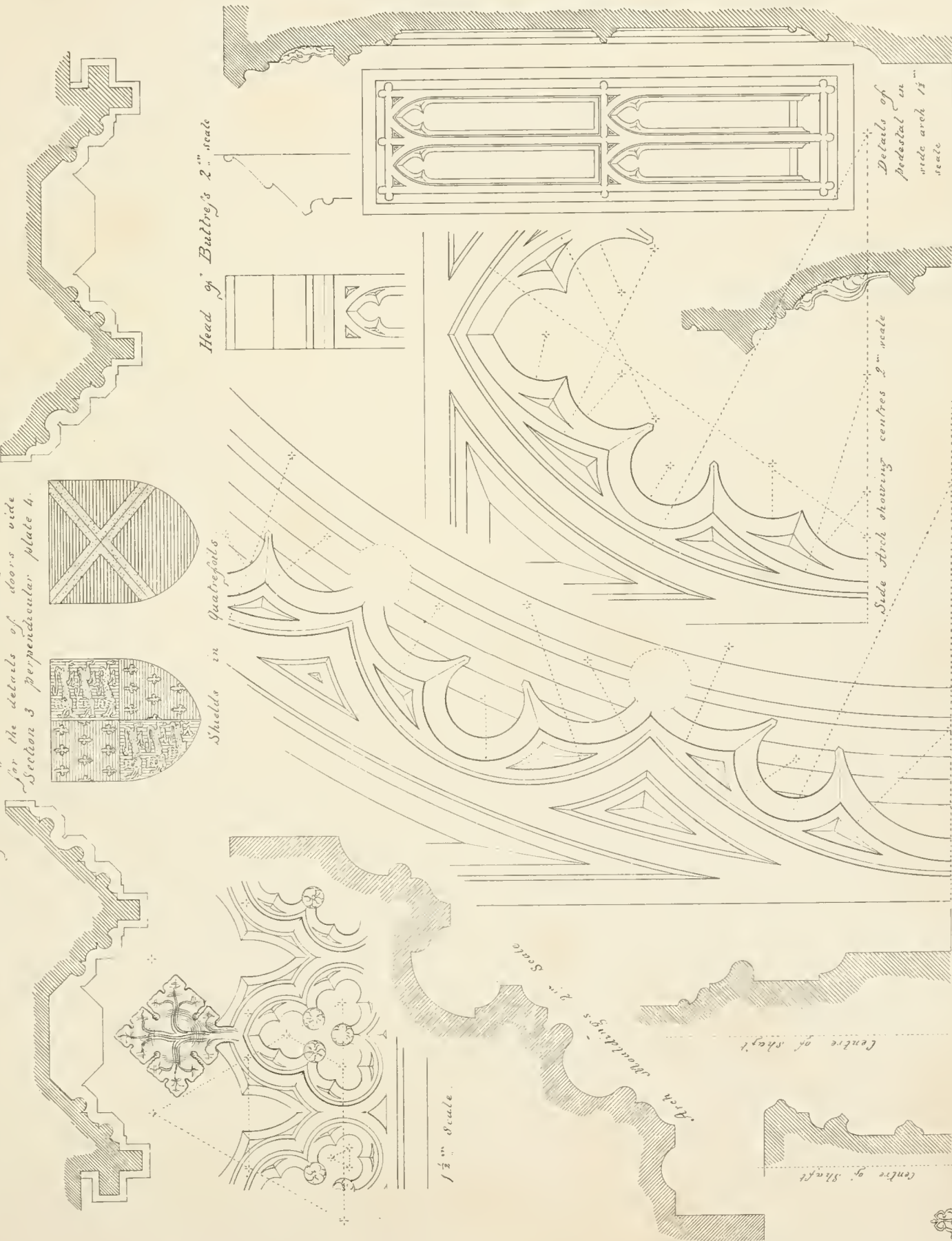
Doorway in South Aisle leading to Cloisters, St. Alban's Abbey, Hertfordshire. *See*

Plan & details of Doorway in S Aisle leading to cloisters S^t Alban's Abbey.

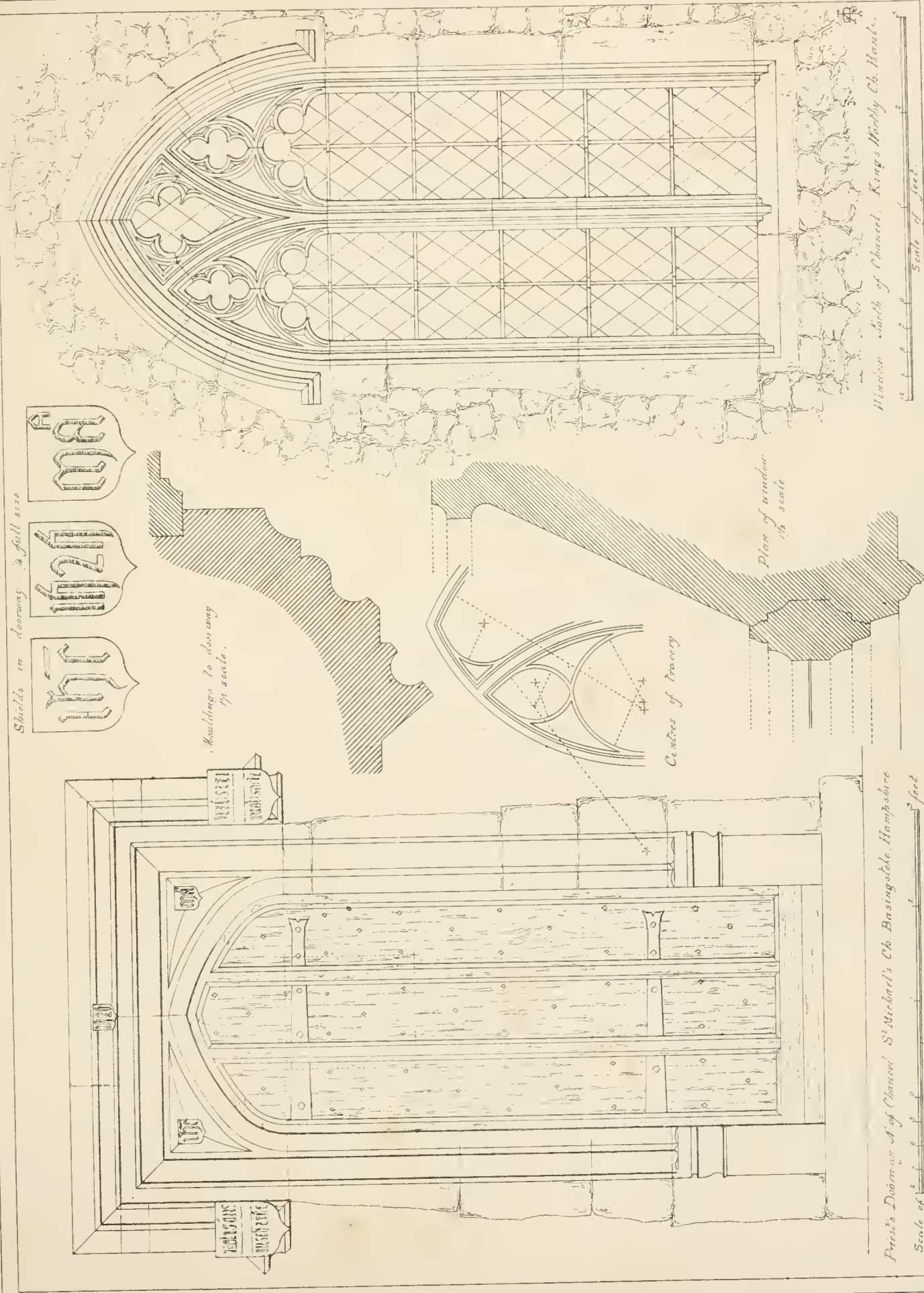

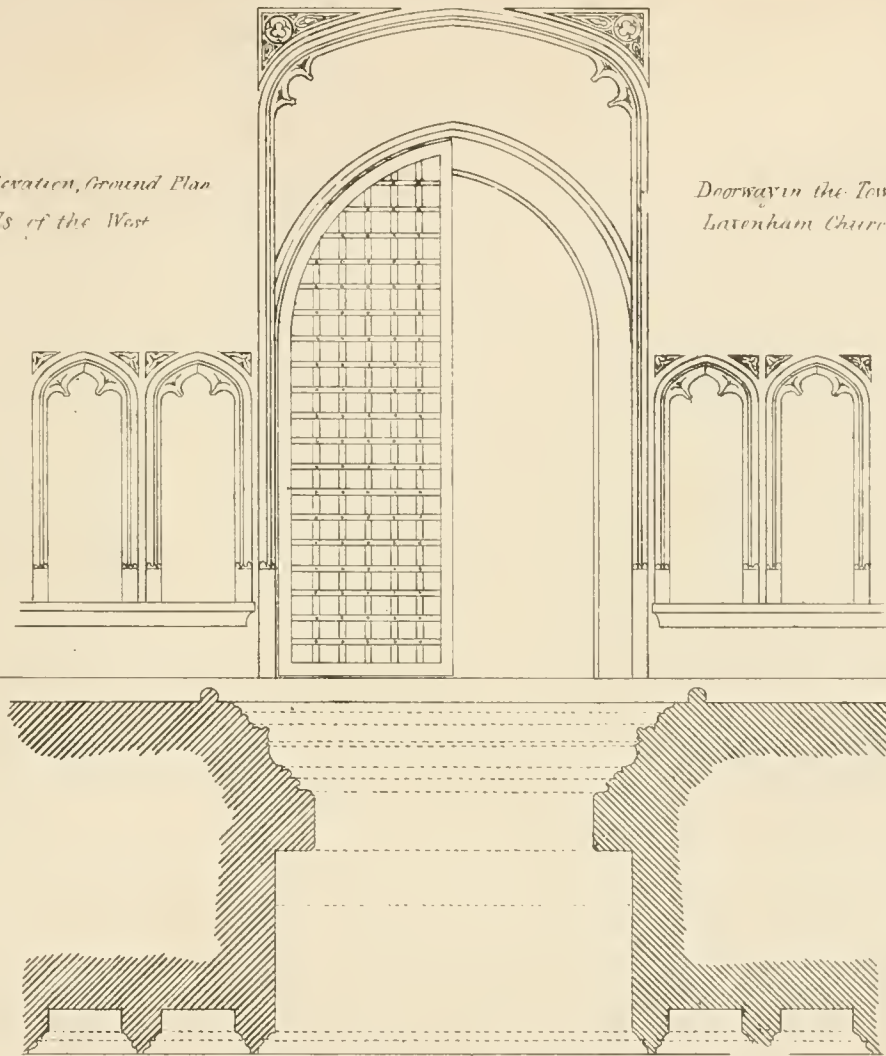


Interior Elevation, Ground Plan and Details of the West

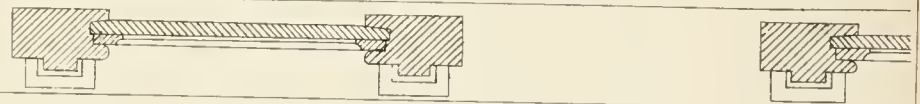


Elevation of Standard.

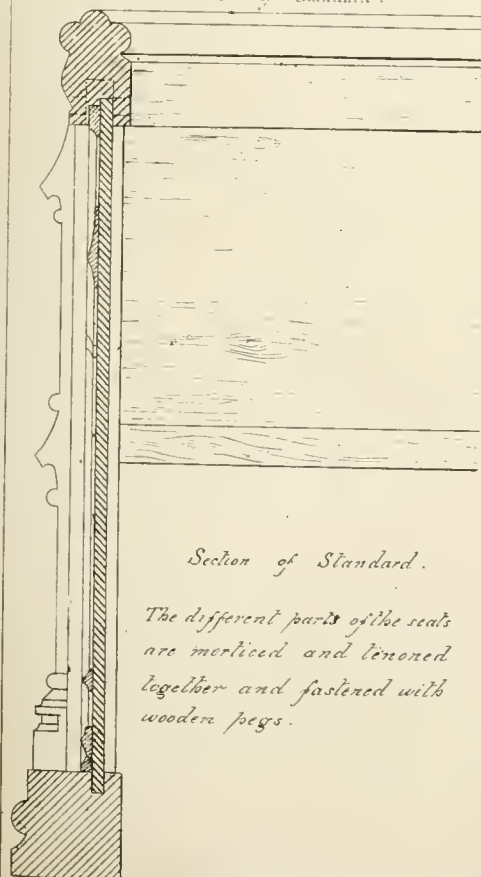

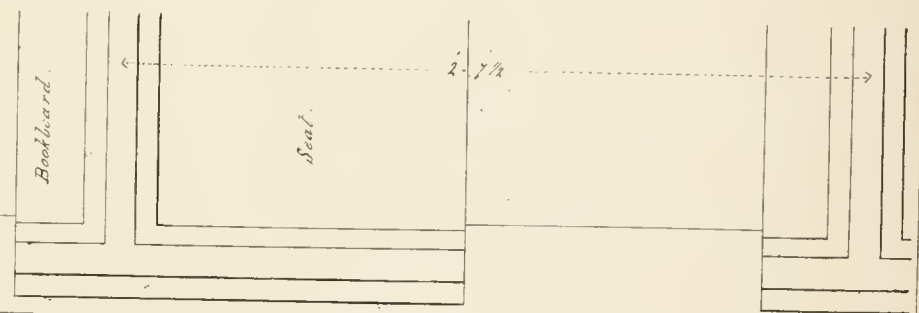


Plan of seats

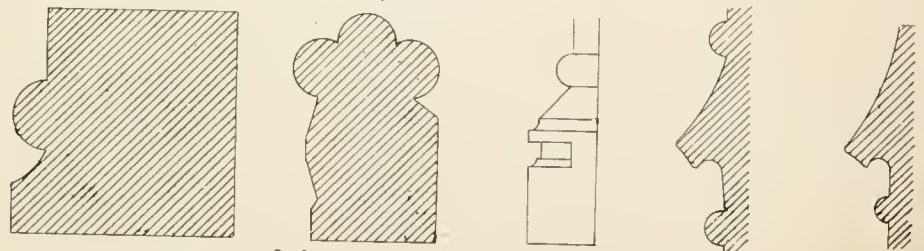
