

MAVA 5334 24 April 1950

The "Academiker Verein" (apparently a cover name for the MHMK) in Vienna was represented by Attila DOSZA, who was kidnapped and repatriated to Hungary by Aurel CZIBKERT. Ladislaus FORTHUBER, Collegium Hungaricum resident, replaced DOSZA.

MAY 1113 18 May 1949

DOSZA's group is gradually becoming active again after the kidnapping of its leader, Otto DEUTSCH, apparently a member of the group, recently crossed the frontier with papers intended for the SPOs. He was picked up by Austrian border guards and then to SPOs headquarters in Vienna I, where a Mr. HERZOG vouched for him. Subject gave HERZOG all his documents, including some which were not originally intended for the SPOs, but these were confiscated by Andrew GROUTGORVITZ, a CIC agent, who learned of them through one "Hugo."



Reported to [ ] that he has learned recently from Andreas KASTALIK, president of the Freiwilliger Verein in Vienna of the existence of an association of former Hungarian officers called Kopjasek (Kopjas) (Leno-za), who engage in intelligence operations into Hungary. It is possible that this group has been working with French intelligence. The group's headquarters is located somewhere in Western Europe. It was represented in Vienna by Attila DOZSA, who was kidnapped and repatriated to Hungary by János CZIBIK RT, now living in Dornbirn, Vorarlberg. The present representative, Ladislau FORTHEIMER, a resident of the Collegium Hungaricum, is in charge of supplying documents.

16 August 1950 [ ] has learned from a discussion with Andreas KASTALIK that the Vienna representative of KOPJASEK is a certain "Irene" (this is presumed to be a cover name). This man is allegedly a former MI5 officer who is technically proficient. Irene replaces Attila DOZSA. His duties in Vienna consist of receiving and dispatching secret couriers of the KOPJASEK who come through Vienna. He is reportedly completely equipped to produce false documents. He is also alleged to be very cautious, having few friends and going out seldom. His family name is not known.

2. KASTALIK, who is allegedly in contact with CIC, has recently reported this to them. This information may be of some use in our relations with the Zako organization. From the files here, we are not completely certain that the Kopjasek group is affiliated with Zako, but it appears probable that it is.

MGKA-21172, 18 August 1950, info re decision on the CIC inquiry as to whether we are interested in taking over subject.

. . . An undated unaccessioned not in the CIC dossier . . . states that Attila DOSA, agent of CIC, Vienna, has reportedly been arrested, killed or driven to suicide by the HIS strong arm squads in Austria.

d. From 26 March to 6 Apr 1949, Subject was interrogated at the KPO, Szeged, at 6 Bekeu, by a deputy secretary chief who called himself Istvan TATAR. . . . The interrogator was mainly interested in the organization of Attila DOSA; this organization according to Subject, was an anti-Communist organization to which many ex-officers belonged. Subject himself claims to have been contacted by DOSA, whom he knew from the military academy, during 1948 and 1949, and at those meetings assured DOSA that he could count on him (Subject). Subject was also interrogated about Mario FALCHIONE, also an ex-officer and an alleged associate of DOSA. The interrogator (TATAR) made the statement to Subject that unless he is going to act sensible he (Subject) is liable to receive a five year sentence for the attempted flight from Hungary. Subject replied without hesitation that he was willing to do anything. TATAR stated that courier mail had to be taken to [redacted] Belgrade, Yugoslavia; if Subject were to be caught, he would be shot by the Yugoslav authorities. Subject declared himself willing. . .

g. Attila DOSA, mentioned in paragraph 4 above, is known to have [redacted] killed himself and an arresting agent of the Hungarian Political Police at Vienna.

Subject stated that AVO espionage activities have usually been directed from the Szombathely AVO Section. In 1948 Major Miklos SZELE was commander of the Szombathely AVO Section. At that time there were several men working for Szele who regularly made trips to Austria. In 1948 two AVO members, one of whom was fm MOLNAR, went to Vienna, Austria, and urged Attila DOZSA and Istvan PASTI to return to Hungary. As soon as the two arrived in Hungary, they were arrested and are still serving jail sentences. MOLNAR and his partner were [redacted] also in contact with Attila KOVACS, an MHBK representative in Innsbruck [since murdered]. On one occasion the two demanded certain documents from Kovacs which he did not want to give them. During the argument that ensued, Kovacs was killed. MOLNAR and his friend were arrested by the Austrian authorities and are now serving prison terms somewhere in Land Tirol, Austria. . .

1. On 12 November Sandor NAGY-ZDADANYI (also received ZSADANYI) reported Embassy stating he worked inside Hungary for Americans between 1945 and 1948, ~~Hungary~~ and escaped to Austria. Worked for IRO Austria until 1951 when arrested by Soviets, repatriated to Hungary and sentenced to 25 years imprisonment. Freed 27 October by rebels from Vac prison. Arrived Vienna 6 November. Said efforts 1945-1948 were directed by Attila DOZSA, operating Vienna.
2. Subject desires help in rehabilitation since health broken due imprisonment. Temporarily housed Vienna 18, Rothschild Spital.
3. VOB holds no traces Subject but traces Attila DOZSA indicate he was former Vienna representative KOPJASOK (Hung intel organ possibly affiliated ZAKO group) ~~KOPJAS, pre-MHAK~~ according info dated 1950 (MAVA-5334 and MAVA-6335). He also mentioned in EAVA-6126 and VOB-3696 ~~in file which transmitted to Hq.~~
