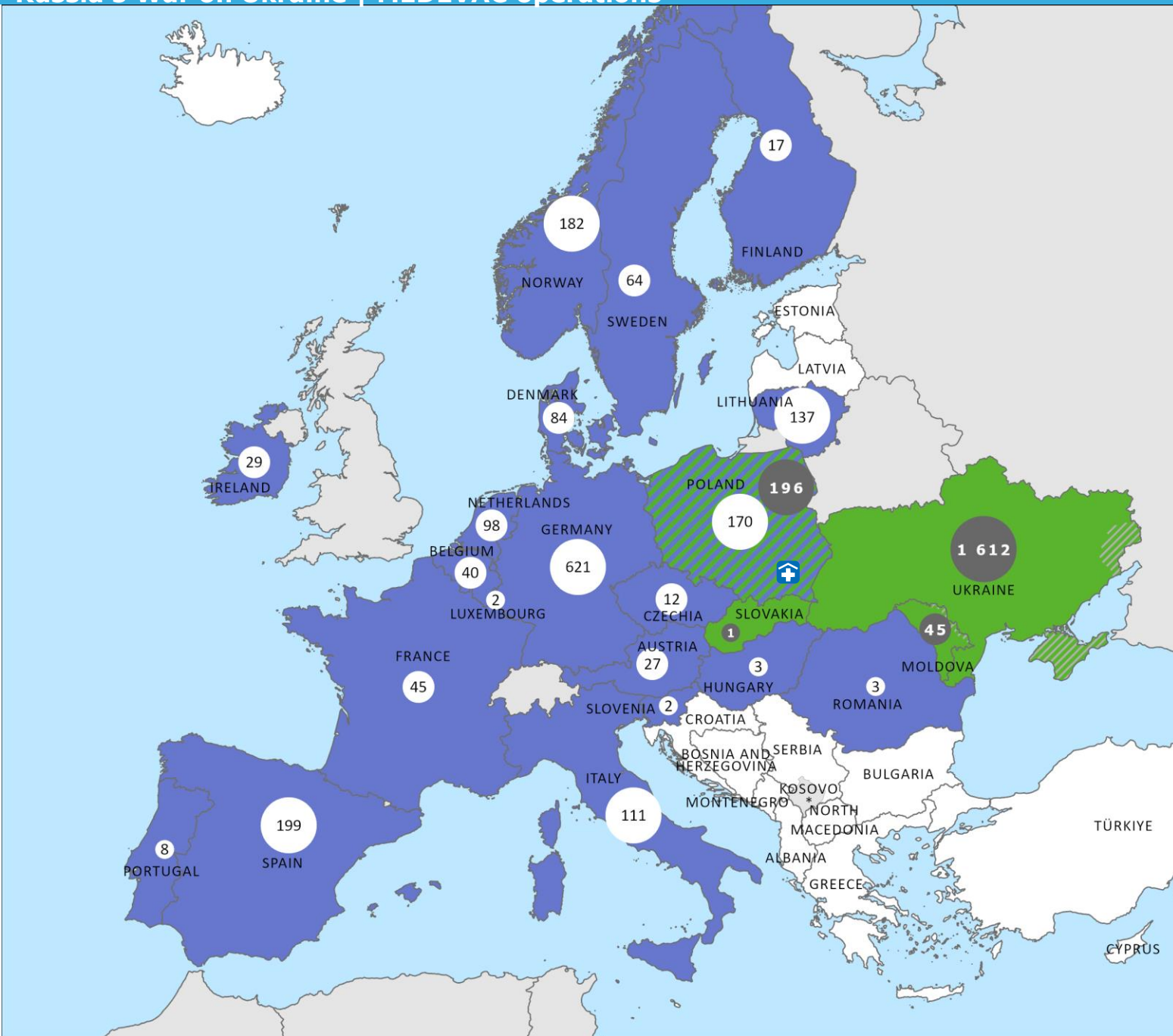


Russia's War on Ukraine | MEDEVAC operations

REQUESTS FOR MEDEVAC OPERATIONS
as of 14 February 16:00 CEST

The European Commission (DG ECHO and DG SANTE) has set up a standard operating procedure for the medical evacuation of Ukrainian people in need of urgent medical care.

Pre-planned flights for groups of MEDEVAC patients have been taking place twice per week since mid-August, using a medicalised plane **offered by Norway**. This is centrally coordinated by the ERCC and by **Medevac liaison officers, who are embedded in the ERCC**.

EU MEDEVAC Hub has been operating since 9 September. The main objective of the hub is to support MEDEVAC operations **through the UCPM**.
