


Why do I contribute to Wikipedia?

Mandatory statistics section

- Over 6.7 million articles
- 5 million edits August 2023
- 38,000 "active editors" (made 5 or more edits)
- Real impressive Internet popularity ranking




Good books, but they don't cover today's Wikipedia






Active editors on Wikipedia

How to use Wikipedia as a reference



A question about Encyclopedias

Is an encyclopedia a collection of all knowledge, or a place to start researching a subject?

(The first is impossible, the second is difficult but possible.)

How reliable is Wikipedia?

- Is Wikipedia more reliable than, say, *Encyclopaedia Britannica*?
- How "complete" is Wikipedia?
- The problem of a fluid text

What to look for in Wikipedia articles

- What everyone sees:

 Articles on subjects
- What everyone does *not* see:

 Talk pages; Article histories; Policy pages and discussions

What to do if I find an error in Wikipedia?

- Leave a message on the talk page
- "Contact us"
- When to edit the article
- Contact editor(s)
- Last resort: contacting the Foundation (do not do this at home)



Challenges as a Contributor

- Finding the material to write articles with
- Interacting usefully with others, both fellow volunteers and individuals outside Wikipedia
- Having a life



Issues in creating/writing an article

- Notability
- No original research
- Competence

These are attempts towards an ideal: to objectively and accurately report information people want or need to know
