

MEMORANDUM FOR: Colonel H. E. Pulliam.

SUBJECT : Boat for Harbor Police Investigation.

1. Reference is made to your directive to me, dated 9 March 1946 calling for a survey and study to be made of the Japanese Coast Guard and Harbor Police facilities. In connection therewith, it would be of the greatest aid to me if a suitable seaworthy boat were to be placed at my disposal, thereby enabling me to more readily, conduct harbor surveys and further the work under my charge.

2. The Army boat F.S.18B now at Yokohama is well suited to my purpose. It is requested that this boat be placed in good seaworthy operating condition, manned by a competent crew and be assigned to me for the purpose above mentioned.
