Summary:

This interview was held for the purpose of securing tables and charts promised us in an interview by Lt. Edwards on 19 Oct. and also to secure further information on Foods.

Two charts showing the distribution flow of commodities from producers to military troops and one table on shipments of rice to forward areas were produced, both in Japanese.

At our request further information on shipments of foods other than rice to troops in forward areas as well as data on number of troops garrisoned on the mainland was promised us in a week's time. Another interview has been scheduled to secure this information at 1000, 30 Oct. 45.
