



SITUATION

- Due to the earthquake that hit the north-eastern province of Rieti on 24 August at 1.36 UTC, with a magnitude of 6.0 M and a depth of 4 km, the death and damage tolls keep rising
- Since the start of the seismic activity until 7.00am this morning, 460 shocks have been registered. Only two have exceeded magnitude 5 M.
- Major damage has been registered in the Municipalities of Amatrice, Accumoli, Gricciano, Arquata del Tronto. So far, 241 fatalities have been reported. Search and rescue operations are still on going.
- Emergency Response Coordination Centre (ERCC) is in contact with the Italian Civil Protection Department and is closely following the situation. ERCC has activated the Copernicus Emergency Management Mapping Service.
