The address of witness is Seoul, Korea, but it is believed that he is in Shanghai.

He is an influential Korean politician and is one of the Koreans who planned the Korean Independence and went to Shanghai to establish the Korean Independent Government there.

The court order dated 4 Dec. 1946 (Paper No. 595 disposes of Paper No. 556 in part only) provides for the interrogation and supplemental request by defense for subpoena of witness; also, for the production of a long list of documents presently located in the USSR, Manchuria, Los Angeles Library and the Washington Document Center.
