

“Guide to the Preliminary Examination.”

THE second edition of this popular work for young druggists has been considerably extended by the inclusion of algebra, Euclid, French, and German in it. The extended pharmaceutical Preliminary examination, which comes into force after July, 1900, will be practically the same as the medical Preliminary. The Boards of Examiners are now considering what examinations should be recognised, as the Pharmaceutical Society has obtained power by by-law to drop its own examination. It will be some time before the Board's decision is known, but Mr. Dodds, the author of the “Guide,” treats the new subjects liberally, and with the lucidity which experience of the more popular examinations can only ensure. The Latin, English, and arithmetic chapters are based upon the papers given in the Pharmaceutical Preliminary examination, and therefore the information is of immediate use. Under algebra the requirements of the Oxford Local examinations are described, text-books are named, and a series of test-papers set and worked out. Euclid is treated on similar lines. Under French, the papers set by the Examiners of the College of Preceptors and the Educational Institute of Scotland, as well as those in the Oxford and Cambridge examinations, are fully referred to, advice given in regard to books and preparation, and a series of six test-papers are set, which enable the author to give the student good counsel in regard to answering. The same method is followed under German. In an appendix, which it is our intention to keep up to date, the regulations of the College of Preceptors and Educational Institute of Scotland are given, with the questions set at Christmas, 1898, and September, 1899; also regulations and advice concerning the London University Matriculation examination, Oxford Local examination, and Cambridge Local examination.

The book in its new form is equally suitable for students who are going forward to medicine, dentistry, veterinary surgery, or science. The new chapters make it a bulkier book than the first edition, and the price has been advanced from 2s. to 2s. 6d., or post free 2s. 9d. This little work is offered to the pharmacist, not with the object of fostering the much discussed and generally vexatious practice of counter-prescribing, but rather as a means of providing necessary information to a class of men whose daily occupation is that of supplying the remedies for diseased humanity. It is held that the better one is informed the more intelligently can this be performed, and, further, that the more conversant the pharmacist is with the nature of disease, the less liable is he to assume the responsibility of invading the physician's domain, devoid of the latter's technical and practical knowledge. Another thought in this connection. There are numerous cases of slight ailments constantly coming under the pharmacist's attention, where simple remedies are required, and where the patient will not consent to employ a physician; in such cases the pharmacist should be able to render intelligent assistance. Granted these contentions, then, this little work is admirably adapted to perform the mission upon which it is sent forth. The arrangement is alphabetical of diseases, and each disease is defined, the symptoms outlined, and treatment suggested in simple style, as free as possible from technicalities. The book is printed in clear, readable type, on good paper, and well bound in cloth.—*Canadian Pharmaceutical Journal*.
