A source who has furnished reliable information in the past advised that on June 30, 1956, [Harry C. Klemfuss] [S] Dominican Republic Information Center in New York City, conferred with [Dominican Consul General Arturo Espaillet] [S] New York City, regarding an article being written by Edward J. Mowery of the "New York Herald Tribune" for release on July 1, 1956. [Espaillet] indicated he had [S] received a report reflecting that Alfonso Naranjo in Chile, who has a copy of the De Galindez manuscript, was a close friend of De Galindez and of a Spaniard by the name of Rodolfo Bosh Pearson, also a close friend of De Galindez. [Espaillet] stated Pearson had disappeared without a trace in Argentina in 1948 but he had located Pearson's wife in New York City and she "told him about it" but does not want to be involved because she is remarried to an American. The source stated [Klemfuss] again conferred with [Espaillet] on July 1, 1956, regarding the [Liberty] article [S] which appeared in the "New York Herald Tribune" on that date, which article stated De Galindez had collected more than one million dollars on behalf of exiled Basques during the past seven years. [Klemfuss] indicated he would inform [S] cc - 1 - AAG Warren Olney III (by 0-6 same date)
