Rocket and strafing attacks were made at Ishigaki airfield and upon a grass field in the center of the island. At the latter field four direct rocket hits were seen in one AA emplacement and 2 hits in another. The balance of the rockets were unobserved. Two fires were started in this area.

At Ishigaki field a single engine plane was burned, a fuel storage burned and two rocket hits scored on AA emplacement. A fire was also started in a wooded area. A lugger was strafed and left smoking near Ishigaki.
