MEDERO was apprehended at New York City, September 28, 1959, by INS, as a stowaway who had arrived September 6, 1959 at Baltimore, Maryland. He was deported at New York City October 21, 1959 via Cubana Airlines. Subject was wanted at the time of deportation, for robbery by the Cuban police. Subject had been convicted of robbery in Cuba in 1956 and served 2½ years in a Havana prison. Subject was described as follows:
