
Movement Charter Drafting Committee

(S)Election Process

The **Movement Charter** will be a document defining roles and responsibilities for all the members and entities of the Wikimedia Movement, including laying out a new Global Council for movement governance. The Movement Charter is a Movement Strategy priority.

The **Movement Charter Drafting Committee** will create a draft of this Charter. The work includes research and consulting with communities, experts, and organizations.

This group will have around 15 members. It is expected to represent diversity in the Movement.

Call for Candidates

Members from across the Wikimedia Movement self-nominate themselves, to serve on the Drafting Committee.

Oct



Voting

All (eligible) Wikimedians across all projects vote on their preferred candidates, using the Single Transferable Vote system.

by Oct 10



Selectors from Affiliates

All afiliates are divided into 8 geographical regions and 1 thematic region. Each region chooses 1 selector.

If needed, Wikimedia Foundation can support the process to choose a selector.

by Nov 1

Election results

7 candidates with the most votes are elected.

by Oct 25

Selection

All selectors meet and make a preferential list, from which **6 candidates** will be appointed.

WMF appoints **2 candidates** from the candidate pool.

Nov 1

Committee Constituted

The Movement Charter Drafting Commmittee is constituted with 15 members (7 + 6 + 2).
