<p>1. The following extract from letter, General Headquarters, Far East Command, subject: Security of Military Information, AG 380.01 (10 Jul 50) GB, 10 July 1950 is reproduced for your information and compliance.</p> <p>"1. At this time, when operational forces of the United States are engaged in this theater in an effort to protect a friendly nation against communist invasion and to reestablish peace, it must be obvious to all American military and civilian personnel, as well as all other persons in Japan, that dissemination of rumors or information which might have a bearing upon the military operations is detrimental to the security of the United States, the United Nations and all nations in the Far East, as well as the safety of American and Korean personnel.</p> <p>2. All persons, military and civilian, connected with the occupation in Japan are warned against spreading of rumors or discussion of information with regard to military operations, plans, personnel or equipment which may come to their knowledge officially or otherwise. This warning applies both to oral discussion and written communications.</p> <p>3. Commanding officers of all units and commands within the Far East Command are directed to familiarize all military and civilian personnel under their jurisdiction with the provisions of AG 380-5.</p> <p>4. All military and civilian personnel are hereby directed to report to their commanding officers any instances of violation of this directive. Commanding officers will investigate the circumstances, and take appropriate disciplinary action."</p> <p>2. Section Chiefs will submit a certificate to this headquarters certifying that all personnel of their section are familiar with the applicable portions of AG 380-5.
