With reference to the Department's instruction No. 288 of December 16, 1946, concerning the repatriation to the United States of the ashes of Allied dead buried in mass graves in Japan, I have the honor to report that upon receipt of the instruction a note dated January 5, 1947 was transmitted to the Netherlands Ministry for Foreign Affairs requesting the Ministry to obtain permission from the appropriate authorities for the cremated remains of the decedents to be brought to the United States for final burial.

Repeated oral inquiries have been made to the Foreign Ministry in an effort to expedite action on the Department's instruction but in each instance, Dr. A. Adriaanse, the Chief of the Juridical Section of the Foreign Ministry, upon checking with the appropriate official in the Ministry of Overseas Territories, has informed the Embassy that the decision which rests with the Netherlands East Indies Government has not been reached. When the matter was discussed with Dr. Adriaanse today he expressed deep regret at the delay, which he admitted was inexcusable, and promised to press the Ministry of Overseas Territories for an immediate reply.


Dear Sir:
