Rule for Grant-in-Aid for Land Improvement Affairs Institution

Article 1. The Minister of Agriculture and Forestry shall, under the provision of Article 16 of the Local Finance Law (Law No. 109 of 1948), grant subsidies to To, Do, Fu and prefectures for expenditures necessary for business and affairs attending the execution of the Land Improvement Law (Law No. 195 of 1949) and the Enforcement Law of the Land Improvement Law (Law No. 196 of 1949) in pursuance of this Rule.

Article 2. The expenditures provided in the preceding Article shall be as follows:

(1) Expenditures necessary for guidance of new construction of land improvement districts and leagues thereof (hereinafter called "land improvement district, etc."), reorganization into land improvement district, etc. of Cultivated Field Associations and Federations thereof, Common Water Use Associations and Federations thereof or Hokkaido Land Work Associations and operation of land improvement district, etc.;

(2) Expenditures necessary for guidance and direction of exchange and consolidation of agricultural land, etc. under the Land Im-

provement Law;
(3) Expenditures necessary for opening of training-meeting of staff engaged in operation of the Land Improvement Law;

(4) Expenditures necessary for training tech-

nical personnel engaged in land-substitutingdisposition;

(5) Expenditures necessary for establishment of personnel engaged in affairs relating to the Land Improvement Law.

The proportion of grant-in-aid to the expenditures provided in the preceding paragraph is

Article 3. In the event that, under the provision of Article 3 of Regulations for Defrayment of Government Allotments and Grant-in-Aid (hereinafter called "Regulation"), a petition of subsidies therefor is filed by To, Do, Fu and prefectures, then the same must be accompanied by the following documents (four copies) to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry:

(1) Written project plan (Form No. 1 shown in the appendix);

(2) Written estimate of receipts and disbursements (Form No. 2 shown in the appendix);
(3) Other documents the Minister of Agricul-

ture and Forestry deems necessary.

Article 4. In the event important changes are attempted to statements in the documents mentioned in the preceding Article, To, Do, Fu and prefectures must make a notice thereof to the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry beforehand.

2 On the receipts of the notice of the preceding paragraph, the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry may order to make changes, if deemed necessary, to matters notified.

Article 5. The written results of projects and the written settlements of accounts, which are to be filed under Article 7 of Regulation shall be prepared in Forms No. 1 and No. 2 shown in the appendix, respectively.

2 The Minister of Agriculture and Forestry may in some cases ask for the filing of documents deemed necessary in addition to the said written results of projects and written settlement of accounts.

Supplementary Provision:

This Rule shall apply as from January 1, 1950.


