1. The Sitrep was initially directed to be compiled by G-2 from stencils prepared by the various staff sections, G-3, G-4 and G-2. Stencils from G-3 on Part II of the Sitrep Operations and from G-4 on Part III Logistics are delivered to G-2 at approximately 1800 daily. Stencils for the heading and Part I - Intelligence are prepared by G-2.

The completed Sitrep is mimeographed as soon as possible thereafter and dispatched between 2000/2100 hours.

2. I note C/S ROK edit last night. I recommend the following change of procedure:

- a. That the various sub-sections submit their contributions or paragraphs to C/S ROK at 1800 in draft form.
- b. This leaves the C/S ROK entirely free to edit the manuscript.
- c. Upon edit, at the convenience of the C/S ROK, the revised manuscript can be turned over to AG for dispatch.

2. This procedure is effective as of 10 July 1950.

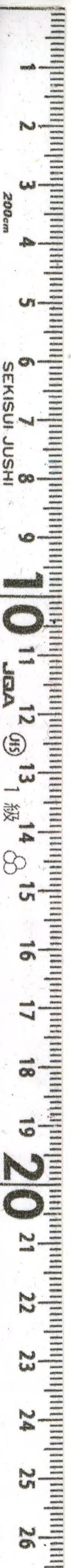

1. Reference radio AG 99599 which requires two (2) SITRIPs each day from CINCPAC, to arrive in Washington at 1200 Z time and 2400 Z time.
2. This has been coordinated with the other Staff Sections and it has been agreed that G-2 shall be the primary agency for assembling the several parts of these reports.
3. The SITRIP will cover the periods from 0001 to 1200 and 1201 to 2400 (our time), or 1001Z to 0200Z and 0201Z to 1000Z respectively. The SITRIP will consist of five (5) parts as follows:
 - a. Part 1 - Intelligence
 - b. Part 2 - Operations
 - c. Part 3 - Logistics
 - d. Part 4 - Personnel
 - e. Part 5 - Miscellaneous
4. *Request* - G-1, G-3 and G-4 will submit their *Portions* parts to the G-2 Radio Room at 0600 and 1800 (*key* time). T/Int will submit G-2 portion of these daily SITRIPs so as to reach the Exec Group by 0500 and 1700 (our time). This will permit Gen Willoughby or his representative to approve the principle report which will be dispatched to AG radio and Cable at about 1800 (our time). The 0500 report will be a supplemental report and will be used to fill in the principle 1800 report.
5. The first SITRIP covering period 2400K to 1200K today will be transmitted at 1700K, 28 June 1949.

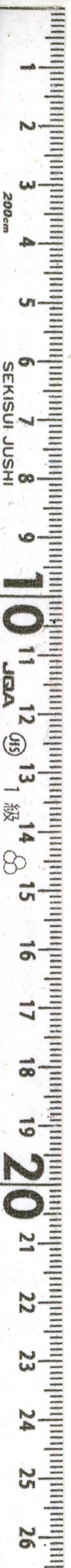
