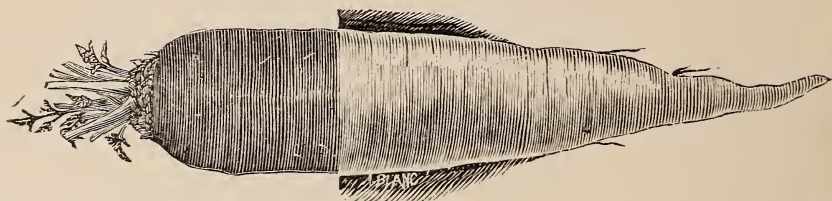

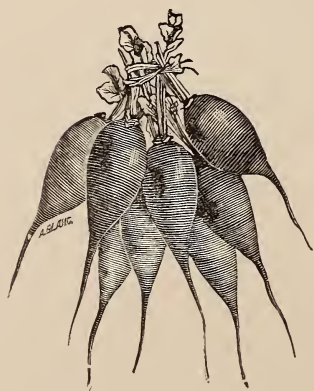

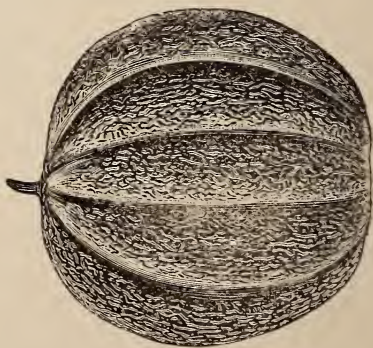

## SEASON OF 1889.

---

Having completed my stock for the season now opening, I take occasion to hand to the merchants of the country my ANNUAL TRADE LIST.

Prices herein given will be adhered to as nearly as possible during the season; but, in case of an unavoidable advance in any article, the same will be noted on the bills of parties ordering, and the privilege of declining the goods at the advanced rate will be acceded to the purchaser, provided they are returned at once.

In case there should be a reduction in any article from prices herein given, my customers will receive the benefit of such reduced price, notwithstanding the prices named in this list.

Buyers of small amounts of cheap articles, or of quantities of less than a pound of any one kind, must expect to pay a small advance on these prices.

Twenty-five pounds of any article will be sold at the 100-pound rate, with the exception of Peas, Beans, Corn, Clover, and Grass Seeds. Special prices for large quantities given on application. Buyers of large amounts of Clover and Grass Seeds should send to me for figures, without regard to prices in this List, or quotations they may have from other sources.

I beg once more to call the attention of dealers to the fact that my goods are the best of the kind that can be procured, and request my customers not to confound them with the various cheap articles often found in this market. Notwithstanding this, however, I, in common with all large dealers of character and standing, do not warrant my seeds in any particular whatever. If the purchaser does not accept them on these terms, they must be returned at once.

My Vegetable and Flower Seeds, put up in papers, well assorted and conveniently arranged in boxes for selling, and supplied with fine show posters and cards, are for sale by responsible merchants in all the country west of the Rocky Mountains, Texas and other Southern States, and are largely exported to Australia, New Zealand, the Sandwich Islands, and Mexico. Merchants who are not supplied with an assortment in this form are invited to write for prices and terms.

My Large Illustrated and Descriptive Catalogue contains a RETAIL PRICE LIST OF SEEDS IN BULK, and my customers should consult this when they desire to know what would be a fair price to charge their customers for seeds by the pound, ounce, or hundred-weight.

Seeds can be sent by mail at the rate of 8 cents per pound postage, and by express at 16 cents or less.

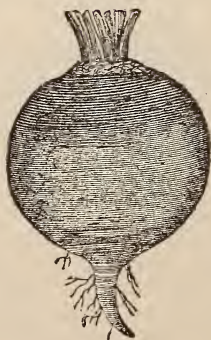

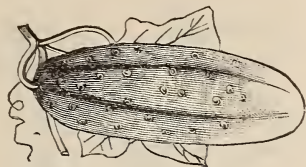

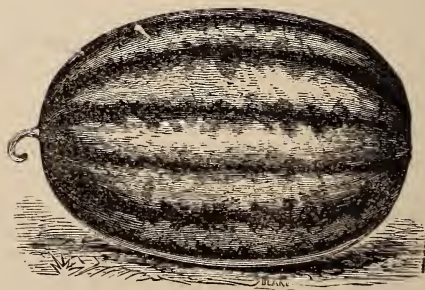
