
## Emergency Response Coordination Centre (ERCC) – ECHO Daily Map | 02/09/2015 Myanmar/Burma - Floods





## **SITUATION**

- Heavy rain continued affecting several areas of Myanmar / Burma over the last few days, causing more floods and landslides, including in the areas already affected by the recent floods. Approx. 69 mm of rain were observed in 24 h in Hkamti (Sagaing Region) and 65 mm in Sittwe (Rakhine State) over 31 August 1 September.
- As of 1 September, media reported floods in the areas of Hpakant, Mogaung, and Mohnyin (Kachin State), with one person reported killed by the floods in Mogaung; while in Chin State, at least 20 people were still missing and approx. 180 houses were reported destroyed after a landslide hit a village in the Township of Tonzang on 28 August.
- Over the next 48 h, more heavy rain may affect several areas of Myanmar / Burma, especially the northern areas (Kachin and northern Sagaing States), as well as the south-west coast (Rakhine State) and some areas of southeast Kayin State.
