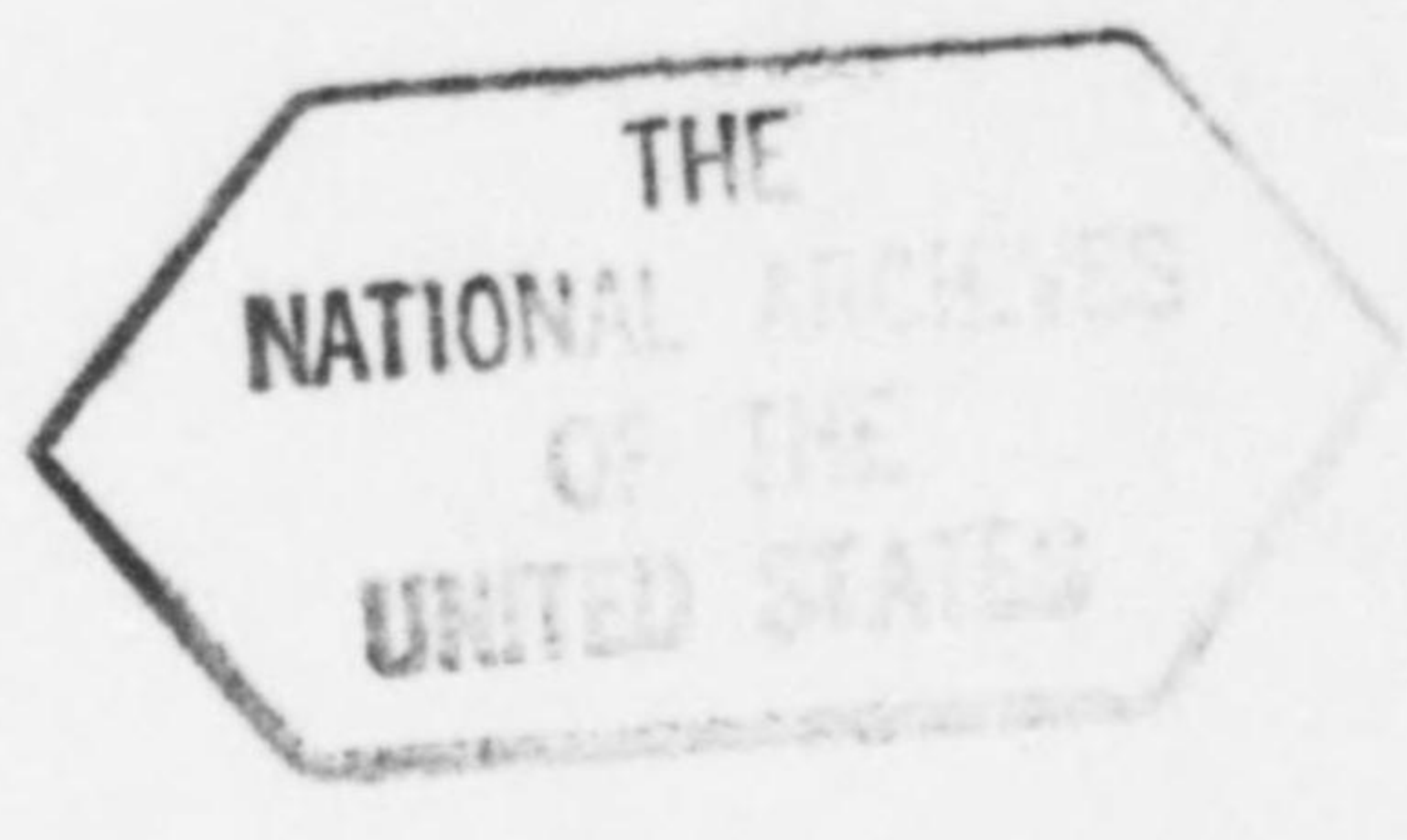

Purpose:

1. Sendai Bosheryo was established in 1940 and is owned and operated by the Sendai City Soc. Works

2. 16 families live in the building which has fourteen rooms. There are 16 mothers and 19 children, 5

of whom are pre-school age.

3. Children of working mothers go to the near-by Buddhist Nursery.

4. 8 households receive Daily Life Security Assistance through a Minseimin in the neighborhood. They pay rent of 20 or 36 yen a month as well as the other households do, the sum coming from their D.L.S.A. grant. The woman manager collects the rent and says that all pay regularly. \* They also pay for water and electricity.

Comments &amp; Suggestions

5. Medical service and room are not available. \*

6. All of the women work, either at dressmaking, teaching or clerking.

This is the 2nd Bosheryo of the 3 existent in Miyagi which has been studied. Mrs. Nishimura stated that there are 3 important things about such homes that she plans to work on - living standards (conditions) of Bosheryo's, nurseries for the children either in or near the Bosheryo's (there are only 31 nurseries in Miyagi) and vocational training opportunities for the mothers. It would seem that more homes of this nature would help alleviate the problems of widowed women with children, regarding housing at least.

\* Mrs. Nishimura states that the minimum standards for children's facilities is not yet a law.
