

Basics and Policies


Wikis

- A website where anyone can edit any page at any time
- Meant to be "quick"
- Remembers all versions (nothing ever destroyed)
- Hyperlinks between pages

Wikipedia policies

- Neutral Point of View written so all sides can agree
- Notability significant independent sources -> importance
- **Verifiability** Using reliable sources to reference information
- No original research point to existing scholarship
- Assume good faith start with congenial spirit
- Conflicts of interest disclose and abide by terms of service

Early life [edit | edit source]

Vikander was born in Gothenburg, [2] the daughter of Maria Fahl Vikander, a stage actress, and Svante Vikander, a psychiatrist. Her parents are from small villages in the north and south of Sweden, respectively. [3] They separated when Vikander was two months old, [4][5][6] and she was mostly raised by her single mother. She has five half-siblings [7] on her father's side. Vikander has said that she had the best of both worlds growing up, being an only and to be mother and being surrounded by a big family when she went to her father's house every second week. [8] Her ancestry is Swedish and one quarter Fire ish. [3]

Vikander started her career as an actor at the age of seven, starring in a production of *Kristina från Duvemåla* at The Göteborg Opera, which was written by the Mamma Mia! creators, Björn and Benny from ABBA; she performed in the play for three-and-a-half years. [6] She appeared in several musicals at the Opera, such as *The Sound of Music* and *Les Misérables*. In 1997 she participated in the TV4 kids' singing show *Småstjärnorna*; she performed the Hele mass song "Du måste finnas". [9] She won her episode with praise by the judges for her stage presence. [10]

Vikander trained in ballet from the age of nine with the *Svenska Balettskolan i Göteborg* (1998–2004). At the age of 15, Vikander mat the ballet's upper school in Stockholm; she lived on her own, working to become a principal dancer. [8] She traveled around the world for training one summer at the School of American Ballet in New York City. [11]

At the age of 16, she almost left school to commit fully to the television series she worked on with director Tomas Alfredson, realizing her

Let's Practice...

Edit w/ Visual Editor = What you see is what you get (mostly)


- 1. Locate article
- 2. Select 'Edit'

3. Unsure if you are in Visual Editor?Select the Pencil (red arrow), select 'Visual editing'4. Edit as you would in a word processor




Cite your sources

Place cursor in desired location, select 'Cite'
 Follow prompts




Create links between articles

1. Select text 2. Select link icon 3. Select article and 'Done'



Don't forget to 'Save Changes'



Explore linked articles

- Search linked articles for relevant information
- 'Copy and Paste' is acceptable between WP articles as long as content is relevant
 - Also a good way to find new sources



- 3. To Redirect, select icon w/ three lines. 2. Select Page settings.


