Girls stayed home and learned dance, cooking, and cleaning and other traditions with their mothers. Hieratic script was generally written on papyrus. Papyrus is a paper made from reeds.

Scribes, Hieroglyphs, and Rosetta Stone were important cultures of language to Ancient Egypt. Language was used everyday scribes wrote everywhere, Hieroglyphs were used to decorate tombs, Rosetta was mixed with multiple languages.
