Just before his return to Japan, in March 1930, he was appointed Chief of the Accounting Section of the Accountants Bureau of the Ministry of Finance, and after his return, worked in that post until November 1932.

The function assigned to the chief of the Accounting Section related to various financial laws and regulations and to regulations of various pays for government employees.

At that time the officials of the Accountants Bureau were respectively in charge of the scrutiny of budgets presented by various government offices. Mr. Kaya, who was then the Chief of the Accounting Section of the same bureau, was concurrently entrusted by me with the work of examining the budget of the Ministry of Education. The man who was in charge of examining the budgets of War and Naval Ministries was at that time Mr. Shoji Arakawa. Consequently Mr. Kaya had nothing to do with

the drawing-up of the budget of War Ministry for the years 1931 and 1932.

Side by side with the work of examining the budget of Education Ministry, Mr. Kaya was particularly in charge of the budgetary affairs on items to be readjusted as a consequence of the London Disarmament Agreement and on reductions of taxes made possible by the said agreement. This was because of the good knowledge he possessed about pertinent data on the relation between the disarmament agreement and the naval budget, as he was a member of the Japanese delegation to attend the daid conference. This, however, was only for the year 1930.

Since then until May 1936 when he was transferred to the post of Chief of the Financial Bureau of the Finance Ministry, he was continuously in charge of examination of the budgets of all government offices including military budgets of the War and the Naval Ministries. official is not held responsible to the outsiders for his work done in conformity with his superior official's orders,

 of such a disarmament pact as would limit to the minimum
 the armaments of the powers attending the conference.
 How earnestly he endeavored for such purposes is still
 vivid in my memory.
